| <b>escrow</b>        | A deposit or fund held in trust or as a security.<br><i>Those funds are <b>escrowed</b> for the purpose of improving municipal services.</i>             |
| <b>indoor</b>        | Relating to sports played indoors.<br><i><b>Indoor</b> sports.</i>   |
| <b>indoors</b>       | Into or within a building.<br><i>The rain makes <b>indoors</b> feel so warm and safe.</i>  |
| <b>inland</b>        | Situated in the interior of a country rather than on the coast.<br><i>A network of waterways that allowed <b>inland</b> trade.</i>                       |
| <b>inmost</b>        | Situated or occurring farthest within.   |
| <b>inner</b>         | The inner part of something.<br><i>A test of <b>inner</b> strength.</i>  |
| <b>inside</b>        | Being or applying to the inside of a building.<br><i>An <b>inside</b> pocket.</i>  |

| <b>interior</b>    | The inner part of something; the inside.<br><i>The plains of the <b>interior</b>.</i>  |
| <b>internal</b>    | Inside the body.<br><i><b>Internal</b> flights.</i>  |
| <b>intramural</b>  | Forming part of normal university or college studies.<br><i>An <b>intramural</b> social symbol within the tribe.</i>   |
| <b>inward</b>      | Directed or moving inward or toward a center.<br><i><b>Inward</b> mail.</i>  |

| <b>mural</b>       | A painting or other work of art executed directly on a wall.<br><i>A <b>mural</b> escarpment.</i>  |
| <b>panorama</b>    | An unbroken view of the whole region surrounding an observer.<br><i>The galleries will offer a full <b>panorama</b> of 20th century art.</i>                                 |
| <b>position</b>    | The relative position or standing of things or especially persons in a society.<br><i>The unpleasant situation or <b>position</b> of having to choose between two evils.</i> |
| <b>scene</b>       | The pieces of scenery used in a play or opera.<br><i>They worked all night painting the <b>scenery</b>.</i>  |
| <b>setting</b>     | Arrangement of scenery and properties to represent the place where a play or movie is enacted.<br><i>He changed the <b>setting</b> on the thermostat.</i>                    |
| <b>surround</b>    | Surround so as to force to give up.<br><i>He loves to <b>surround</b> himself with family and friends.</i>   |
| <b>surrounding</b> | Closely encircling.<br><i>The <b>surrounding</b> countryside.</i>  |
| <b>therein</b>     | (formal) in or into that thing or place.<br><i>They can read <b>therein</b> what our plans are.</i>  |
| <b>within</b>      | Inside; indoors.<br><i>Enquire <b>within</b>.</i>  |
