<a href="#">crepuscular</a>	Like twilight; dim. <i>The evening s <b>crepuscular</b> charm.</i>
<a href="#">date</a>	Sweet edible fruit of the date palm with a single long woody seed. <i>The package is <b>dated</b> November 24.</i>
<a href="#">dawn</a>	Come into existence. <i>It was the <b>dawn</b> of the Roman Empire.</i>
<a href="#">daybreak</a>	The time in the morning when daylight first appears; dawn. <i>She set off at <b>daybreak</b>.</i>
<a href="#">dusk</a>	Become dusk. <i>The <b>dusk</b> of the vestry.</i>
<a href="#">furnishing</a>	Furniture, fittings, and other decorative accessories such as curtains and carpets, for a house or room. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious <b>furnishings</b>.</i>
<a href="#">indoor</a>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i><b>Indoor</b> activities for a rainy day.</i>
<a href="#">indoors</a>	Within a building. <i>They went <b>indoors</b> and explored the house.</i>
<a href="#">inmost</a>	Situated or occurring farthest within.
<a href="#">inner</a>	A shot that strikes the inner. <i>An <b>inner</b> room.</i>
<a href="#">inside</a>	On the inside. <i>Overtaking on the <b>inside</b>.</i>

<b>interior</b>	Existing or taking place in the mind or soul; mental. <i>The <b>interior</b> has been much restored.</i>
<b>internal</b>	Inside the body. <i><b>Internal</b> party maneuvering.</i>
<b>intramural</b>	Forming part of normal university or college studies. <i>Both <b>intramural</b> and churchyard graves.</i>
<b>inwardly</b>	Within the mind. <i><b>Inwardly</b> seething he did as he was told.</i>
<b>midnight</b>	12 o'clock at night; the middle of the night. <i>I left at <b>midnight</b>.</i>
<b>monday</b>	The second day of the week; the first working day.
<b>morning</b>	Every morning. <i>A hint of steely light showed that <b>morning</b> was on its way.</i>
<b>noon</b>	Twelve o'clock in the day; midday. <i>The service starts at twelve <b>noon</b>.</i>
<b>o'clock</b>	According to the clock.
<b>rouse</b>	Cause to be agitated excited or roused. <i>She <b>roused</b> and looked around.</i>
<b>sunday</b>	United States evangelist (1862-1935).
<b>therein</b>	In that place, document, or respect. <i>The student has not been resident <b>therein</b>.</i>
<b>tonight</b>	On the present or approaching evening or night. <i>Are you doing anything <b>tonight</b>.</i>
<b>twilight</b>	Lighted by or as if by twilight Henry Fielding. <i>He loved the <b>twilight</b>.</i>
<b>waken</b>	Cause to become awake or conscious. <i>She knew he would <b>waken</b> in an hour or so.</i>
<b>wednesday</b>	The fourth day of the week; the third working day.
<b>within</b>	Inside; indoors. <i>Enquire <b>within</b>.</i>
