access	Reach or gain access to. <i>He took a wrong turn on the access to the bridge.</i>
admittance	The right to enter. <i>People were unable to gain admittance to the hall.</i>
aperture	A natural opening in something. <i>The genital aperture of an insect.</i>
derogatory	Expressive of low opinion. <i>She tells me I m fat and is always making derogatory remarks.</i>
direction	Something that provides direction or advice as to a decision or course of action. <i>New directions in painting and architecture.</i>
disparaging	Expressive of low opinion. <i>Disparaging remarks about the new house.</i>
divert	Send on a course or in a direction different from the planned or intended one. <i>Although the audience members were diverted by this new symphony critics disliked it.</i>
entry	An act of going or coming in. <i>A fluffed entry.</i>
flank	A cut of meat from the flank of an animal. <i>The left flank of the Russian Third Army.</i>
groove	Hollow out in the form of a furrow or groove. <i>Her vocals drift delicately across a soaring soul groove.</i>
indoor	Relating to sports played indoors. <i>Indoor sports.</i>
indoors	Within a building. <i>They went indoors and explored the house.</i>

interior	Situated further in or within. <i>She thinks she has no soul no interior life but the truth is that she has no access to it.</i>
inwardly	Within the mind. <i>Inwardly seething he did as he was told.</i>
lane	A narrow way or road. <i>DNA from various sources is placed in separate lanes on an electrophoretic gel.</i>
left	Location near or direction toward the left side i.e. the side to the north when a person or object faces east. <i>Leftover meatloaf.</i>
northern	Relating to or characteristic of the north or its inhabitants. <i>Northern cities.</i>
occident	The countries of (originally) Europe and (now including) North America and South America.
occidental	Denoting or characteristic of countries of Europe and the western hemisphere. <i>Modern occidental society.</i>
orientation	Familiarization with something. <i>Many judges give instructions to assist jury orientation.</i>
oriented	Adjusted or located in relation to surroundings or circumstances; sometimes used in combination. <i>The book is value oriented throughout.</i>
passage	A narrow way allowing access between buildings or to different rooms within a building a passageway. <i>The nasal passages.</i>
path	A course of conduct. <i>A chosen career path.</i>
pejorative	Expressing disapproval. <i>Most of what he said was inflammatory and filled with pejoratives.</i>
position	An opinion that is held in opposition to another in an argument or dispute. <i>He moved himself into a reclining position.</i>
southwest	The direction corresponding to the southwestward compass point. <i>The winds are southwesterly.</i>
tack	Fasten or fix in place with tacks. <i>The sailors decided to tack the boat.</i>
therein	In or into that thing or place. <i>Therein lie all the problems.</i>

track The soundtrack of a film or video.
*The **track** of an animal.*

unidirectional Operating or moving or allowing movement in one direction only.
*Some sociologists assumed that this ageing process was socially **unidirectional**.*
