Usage Examples of "Inadvertently" as an adverb

• His name had been inadvertently omitted from the list.

Associations of "Inadvertently" (30 Words)

Anything that happens suddenly or by chance without an apparent

<u>accident</u> cause.

He had a little **accident** but I washed his shorts out.

accidentally Without advance planning. They met **accidentally**.

Utter impulsively.

blurt

He blurted out the secret.

In a rakish manner.

carelessly *Carelessly* raised the children's hopes without thinking of their

possible disappointment.

casually Not methodically or according to plan.

I wouldn t introduce my family to people I was **casually** dating.

Coincide Occur at the same time.

The members of the College **coincide** in this opinion.

A remarkable concurrence of events or circumstances without

coincidence apparent causal connection.

The interval determining the **coincidence** gate is adjustable.

Existing at or occurring in the same period of time.

contemporaneous A rise in interest rates is often contemporaneous with an increase in

inflation.

exist Have an existence be extant.

He could barely **exist** on such a low wage.

hap An accidental happening.

What is **hap**pening.

happen Happen occur or be the case in the course of events or by chance.

Two hours had passed and still nothing had **happen**ed.

An event that might have been arranged although it was really

happenstance accidental.

It was just **happenstance** that I happened to be there.

incident (especially of light or other radiation) falling on or striking something.

One person was stabbed in the **incident**.



incidental An incidental expense event etc.

Confusion **incidental** to a quick change.

incidentally In an incidental manner; as a chance occurrence.

Incidentally I won t go to the party.

Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable.

I **just** can t take it anymore.

Exist or be found to be present in a place or under a particular set of

occur conditions.

The accident **occur**red at about 3 30 p m.

overhear Hear, usually without the knowledge of the speakers.

We **overhear**d the conversation at the next table.

simultaneously At the same time.

The telethon was broadcast **simultaneously** on 31 US networks.

synchronism The relation that exists when things occur at the same time.

unaware (often followed by `of') not aware.

Seemed unaware of the scrutiny.

unconsciouslyWithout realizing or being aware of one's actions.

Ben smiled **unconsciously** when he heard her voice.

unexpected Not expected or regarded as likely to happen.

Unexpected guests.

unexpectedlyIn a way that was not expected or regarded as likely.

He died **unexpectedly** of a heart attack.

unintended Not planned or meant.

The **unintended** consequences of people s actions.

unintentionally Without intention; in an unintentional manner.

Unintentionally rude song lyrics.

unknowingly Without knowledge or intention.

unknown An unknown person or thing.

They came like angels out the **unknown**.

unwittingly Without knowledge or intention.
