Present Tense	<b>inaugurate / inaugurates</b>
Past Tense	<b>inaugurated</b>
Present Participle	<b>inaugurating</b>
Past Participle	<b>inaugurated</b>

## Conjugate Inaugurate

**Inaugurate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **inaugurate**                      We **inaugurate**  
You **inaugurate**                    You **inaugurate**  
He/She/It **inaugurates**      They **inaugurate**

**Inaugurate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am inaugurating**                We **are inaugurating**  
You **are inaugurating**            You **are inaugurating**  
He/She/It **is inaugurating**      They **are inaugurating**

**Inaugurate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have inaugurated**                We **have inaugurated**  
You **have inaugurated**            You **have inaugurated**  
He/She/It **has inaugurated**      They **have inaugurated**

**Inaugurate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been inaugurating**        We **have been inaugurating**  
You **have been inaugurating**    You **have been inaugurating**  
He/She/It **has been inaugurating**      They **have been inaugurating**

**Inaugurate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **inaugurated**                      We **inaugurated**  
You **inaugurated**                    You **inaugurated**  
He/She/It **inaugurated**          They **inaugurated**

**Inaugurate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was inaugurating      We were inaugurating  
You were inaugurating      You were inaugurating  
He/She/It was inaugurating      They were inaugurating

**Inaugurate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had inaugurated      We had inaugurated  
You had inaugurated      You had inaugurated  
He/She/It had inaugurated      They had inaugurated

**Inaugurate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been inaugurating      We had been inaugurating  
You had been inaugurating      You had been inaugurating  
He/She/It had been inaugurating      They had been inaugurating

**Inaugurate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will inaugurate      We will inaugurate  
You will inaugurate      You will inaugurate  
He/She/It will inaugurate      They will inaugurate

**Inaugurate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be inaugurating      We will be inaugurating  
You will be inaugurating      You will be inaugurating  
He/She/It will be inaugurating      They will be inaugurating

**Inaugurate in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have inaugurated**

**We will have inaugurated**

**You will have inaugurated**

**You will have inaugurated**

**He/She/It will have inaugurated**

**They will have inaugurated**

**Inaugurate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been inaugurating**

**We will have been inaugurating**

**You will have been inaugurating**

**You will have been inaugurating**

**He/She/It will have been inaugurating**

**They will have been inaugurating**
