I had been incardinating

We had been incardinating

He/She/It had been incardinating **They had been incardinating**

I will incardinate

We will incardinate

You will incardinate

You will incardinate

He/She/It will incardinate **They will incardinate**

I will be incardinating

We will be incardinating

You will be incardinating

You will be incardinating

He/She/It will be incardinating **They will be incardinating**

We will have incardinated
