Synonyms of "Incentivize" as a verb (21 Words)

act as a fillip to	Discharge one’s duties.
act as a impetus to	Perform on a stage or theater.
act as a incentive to	Behave in a certain manner; show a certain behavior; conduct or comport oneself.
act as a spur to	Be suitable for theatrical performance.
act as a stimulus to	Be engaged in an activity, often for no particular purpose other than pleasure.
activate	Make active or more active. <i>Activate an old file.</i>
encourage	Inspire with confidence; give hope or courage to. <i>His financial success encouraged him to look for a wife.</i>

fire	Set fire to. <i>The boss fired his secretary today.</i>
fire with enthusiasm	Go off or discharge.
<u>fuel</u>	Supply or power an industrial plant vehicle or machine with fuel. <i>The tanker fueled in Bahrain.</i>
<u>galvanize</u>	Stimulate (muscles) by administering a shock. <i>The urgency of his voice galvanized them into action.</i>
<u>kindle</u>	(of an emotion) be aroused. <i>A love of art was kindled in me.</i>
<u>motivate</u>	Cause (someone) to have interest in or enthusiasm for something. <i>He said he would motivate funds to upgrade the food stalls.</i>
move	Cause to move or shift into a new position or place both in a concrete and in an abstract sense. <i>She moved to the door.</i>
<u>nourish</u>	Provide with nourishment. <i>I was doing everything I could to nourish and protect the baby.</i>
prompt	Supply a forgotten word or line to (an actor) during the performance of a play. <i>The violence prompted a wave of refugees to flee the country.</i>
spark	Emit or produce sparks. <i>The ignition sparks as soon as the gas is turned on.</i>
spur on	Equip with spurs.
trigger	Release or pull the trigger on. <i>People ask how much I weigh but I won't talk about numbers because I know that triggers me.</i>
whet	Sharpen by rubbing as on a whetstone. <i>The selection of quotations may whet your curiosity to investigate the source material.</i>
