### **Definitions of "Incomplete" as an adjective**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “incomplete” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not having all the necessary or appropriate parts.*
- *Not full or finished.*
- *Not complete or total; not completed.*
- *Not yet finished.*



## Synonyms of "Incomplete" as an adjective (17 Words)

<b>bitty</b>	Tiny. <i>A little <b>bitty</b> girl.</i>
<b><u>defective</u></b>	Having a defect. <i>Dystrophin is commonly <b>defective</b> in muscle tissue.</i>
<b><u>deficient</u></b>	Having mental disabilities. <i>A <b>deficient</b> education.</i>
<b>fragmentary</b>	Consisting of small disconnected or incomplete parts. <i>Excavations have revealed <b>fragmentary</b> remains of masonry.</i>
<b>fragmented</b>	Having been divided; having the unity destroyed. <i>A <b>fragmented</b> coalition.</i>
<b><u>imperfect</u></b>	(of a gift, title, etc.) transferred without all the necessary conditions or requirements being met. <i>Drainage here is <b>imperfect</b>.</i>
<b><u>insufficient</u></b>	Of a quantity not able to fulfill a need or requirement. <i>There was <b>insufficient</b> evidence to convict him.</i>

- not completed** Completed by the first act of sexual intercourse after the ceremony.
- not concluded** Having come or been brought to a conclusion.
- not finished** Having a surface coating or finish applied.
- partial** Having a strong preference or liking for.  
***Partial** immunity.*
- patchy** Not of the same quality throughout; inconsistent.  
***Patchy** fog.*
- scrappy** Determined, argumentative, or pugnacious.  
***Scrappy** lecture notes piled up unread.*
- sketchy** Giving only major points; lacking completeness.  
*A **sketchy** neighbourhood.*
- uncomplete** Not complete or total; not completed.
- uncompleted** Not completed.  
*Five **uncompleted** nuclear power stations.*
- unfinished** Lacking a surface finish such as paint.  
*Her last novel is **unfinished**.*



## Usage Examples of "Incomplete" as an adjective

- *Political consequences of incomplete military success.*
- *Incomplete carvings of cattle.*
- *An incomplete account of his life.*
- *The analysis remains incomplete.*
- *His thesis is still incomplete.*
- *An incomplete forward pass.*



## Associations of "Incomplete" (30 Words)

<b>alliterate</b>	(of a phrase or line of verse) contain words which begin with the same sound or letter. <i>His first and last names <b>alliterated</b>.</i>
<b>alliteration</b>	The occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of adjacent or closely connected words. <i><b>Alliterations</b> are clustered in the last few lines.</i>
<b>approximate</b>	Not quite exact or correct. <i>Her results <b>approximate</b> my own.</i>
<b>biased</b>	Favoring one person or side over another. <i>We will not tolerate this <b>biased</b> media coverage.</i>
<b>dicey</b>	Unpredictable and potentially dangerous. <i>Democracy is a <b>dicey</b> business.</i>
<b>dozen</b>	The cardinal number that is the sum of eleven and one. <i>She has <b>dozens</b> of admirers.</i>
<b>equidistant</b>	At equal distances. <i>The line joins together all points which are <b>equidistant</b> from the two axes.</i>
<b>few</b>	A small elite group. <i><b>Few</b> roses were still blooming.</i>
<b>fractional</b>	Small or tiny in amount. <i>There was a <b>fractional</b> hesitation before he said yes.</i>
<b>fragmentary</b>	Consisting of small disconnected parts. <i><b>Fragmentary</b> remains.</i>
<b>half</b>	Partially or to the extent of a half. <i>A <b>half</b> of bitter.</i>
<b>least</b>	Used in names of very small animals and plants e.g. least shrew. <i>He has the <b>least</b> talent of anyone.</i>
<b>moiety</b>	One of two basic subdivisions of a tribe. <i>The enzyme removes the sulphate <b>moiety</b>.</i>
<b>nearly</b>	In a close manner. <i>David was <b>nearly</b> asleep.</i>
<b>part</b>	The appropriate or expected behaviour in a particular role or situation one's duty. <i>She played a lot of leading <b>parts</b>.</i>
<b>partial</b>	A component of a musical sound; an overtone or harmonic. <i><b>Partial</b> to horror movies.</i>

<b>partially</b>	Only in part; to a limited extent. <i>A <b>partially</b> open door.</i>
<b>pendent</b>	Hanging down or overhanging. <i>The use of jurisdiction to decide <b>pendent</b> claims.</i>
<b>portion</b>	Serve (food) in an amount suitable for one person. <i>His <b>portion</b> was larger than hers.</i>
<b>proximate</b>	Nearly accurate approximate. <i><b>Proximate</b> houses.</i>
<b>quarter</b>	Divide by four divide into quarters. <i>Peel and <b>quarter</b> the bananas.</i>
<b>rough</b>	With rough motion as over a rough surface. <i><b>Rough</b> manners.</i>
<b>section</b>	Commit someone compulsorily to a psychiatric hospital in accordance with a section of a mental health act. <i>A residential <b>section</b> of the capital.</i>
<b>sector</b>	The minimum track length that can be assigned to store information unless otherwise specified a sector of data consists of 512 bytes. <i>Operations in the southern <b>sector</b> of the North Sea.</i>
<b>semi</b>	A semi trailer. <i>She pulled into the path of a <b>semi</b>.</i>
<b>sketchy</b>	Not thorough or detailed. <i>The information they had was <b>sketchy</b>.</i>
<b>some</b>	To some extent quite a lot. <i>We did not meet again for <b>some</b> years.</i>
<b>twelve</b>	Denoting a quantity consisting of 12 items or units.
<b>unfinished</b>	Lacking a surface finish such as paint. <i>The building is still <b>unfinished</b>.</i>
<b>uninformative</b>	Not providing particularly useful or interesting information. <i>The coverage is brief and <b>uninformative</b>.</i>
