### **Definitions of "Indescribable" as an adjective**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “indescribable” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Too unusual, extreme, or indefinite to be adequately described.*
- *Defying expression or description.*



## Synonyms of "Indescribable" as an adjective (9 Words)

- incommunicable** Not able to be communicated to others.  
*The pain of separation took the form of an **incommunicable** depression.*
- indefinable** Not able to be defined or described exactly.  
*An abstract concept that seems **indefinable**.*
- ineffable** Not to be uttered.  
*The **ineffable** Hebrew name that gentiles write as Jehovah.*
- inexpressible** Defying expression.  
*A mood of **inexpressible** longing.*
- nameless** Deliberately not identified; anonymous.  
*Some pictures were taken by a **nameless** photographer.*



<b>undefinable</b>	Not capable of being precisely or readily described; not easily put into words.
<b><u>unspeakable</u></b>	Not able to be expressed in words. <i>I felt an <b>unspeakable</b> tenderness towards her.</i>
<b>untellable</b>	Defying expression or description. <i>A thing of <b>untellable</b> splendor.</i>
<b>unutterable</b>	Defying expression or description. <i><b>Unutterable</b> consonant clusters.</i>



## Usage Examples of "Indescribable" as an adjective

- *Most prisoners suffered indescribable hardship.*

<b>abominable</b>	Exceptionally bad or displeasing. <i><b>Abominable</b> workmanship.</i>
<b>acerbity</b>	Sharpness and directness in speech. <i>Their relationship was built on a certain mutual <b>acerbity</b>.</i>
<b>appalling</b>	An experience that appalls. <i>His conduct was <b>appalling</b>.</i>
<b>atrocious</b>	Horrifyingly wicked. <i><b>Atrocious</b> cruelties.</i>
<b>awful</b>	Awfully very. <i>We re an <b>awful</b> long way from the motorway.</i>

<b>beastly</b>	In a beastly manner. <i><b>Beastly</b> desires.</i>

<b>fearsome</b>	Frightening, especially in appearance. <i>The cat mewed displaying a <b>fearsome</b> set of teeth.</i>
<b>frightful</b>	Extreme in degree or extent or amount or impact. <i>Spent a <b>frightful</b> amount of money.</i>
<u><b>glad</b></u>	Willing and eager (to do something). <i>Heard the <b>glad</b> news.</i>
<b>happy</b>	Satisfied with the quality or standard of. <i>He was not <b>happy</b> about the proposals.</i>
<u><b>hellish</b></u>	Extremely evil or cruel; expressive of cruelty or befitting hell. <i><b>Hellish</b> torture.</i>
<b>horrible</b>	Provoking horror- Winston Churchill. <i>A <b>horrible</b> massacre.</i>
<u><b>horrifying</b></u>	Provoking horror. <i>An alarming even <b>horrifying</b> picture.</i>
<b>ineffable</b>	Not to be uttered. <i>The <b>ineffable</b> mysteries of the soul.</i>
<u><b>inexplicable</b></u>	Incapable of being explained or accounted for. <i>Left the house at three in the morning for <b>inexplicable</b> reasons.</i>
<b>inexpressible</b>	Defying expression. <i>A mood of <b>inexpressible</b> longing.</i>
<b>inscrutable</b>	Of an obscure nature- Rachel. <i>The <b>inscrutable</b> workings of Providence.</i>
<u><b>nasty</b></u>	Annoying or unwelcome. <i>A <b>nasty</b> trick to pull.</i>
<u><b>sheer</b></u>	Cause to sheer. <i>Got the job through <b>sheer</b> persistence.</i>
<u><b>silent</b></u>	Not made to sound. <i>A <b>silent</b> dog whistle.</i>
<b>stygian</b>	Hellish.

<b>terrible</b>	Exceptionally bad or displeasing. <i>I was sick all night and felt <b>terrible</b> for two days.</i>
<b><u>terribly</u></b>	In a terrible manner. <i><b>Terribly</b> interesting.</i>
<b>uncommunicative</b>	Unwilling to talk or impart information. <i>The <b>uncommunicative</b> Emily disappeared.</i>
<b><u>unspeakable</u></b>	Too sacred to be uttered. <i><b>Unspeakable</b> happiness.</i>
<b>unutterable</b>	Defying expression or description. <i>Moments of <b>unutterable</b> grief.</i>
