Present Tense	<b>indignify / indignifies</b>
Past Tense	<b>indignified</b>
Present Participle	<b>indignifying</b>
Past Participle	<b>indignified</b>

## Conjugate Indignify

**Indignify in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **indignify**                      We **indignify**  
You **indignify**                  You **indignify**  
He/She/It **indignifies**      They **indignify**

**Indignify in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am indignifying**              We **are indignifying**  
You **are indignifying**        You **are indignifying**  
He/She/It **is indignifying**    They **are indignifying**

**Indignify in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have indignified**              We **have indignified**  
You **have indignified**        You **have indignified**  
He/She/It **has indignified**    They **have indignified**

**Indignify in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been indignifying**      We **have been indignifying**  
You **have been indignifying**    You **have been indignifying**  
He/She/It **has been indignifying**    They **have been indignifying**

**Indignify in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **indignified**                      We **indignified**  
You **indignified**                  You **indignified**  
He/She/It **indignified**        They **indignified**

**Indignify in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was indignifying      We were indignifying  
You were indignifying      You were indignifying  
He/She/It was indignifying      They were indignifying

**Indignify in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had indignified      We had indignified  
You had indignified      You had indignified  
He/She/It had indignified      They had indignified

**Indignify in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been indignifying      We had been indignifying  
You had been indignifying      You had been indignifying  
He/She/It had been indignifying      They had been indignifying

**Indignify in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will indignify      We will indignify  
You will indignify      You will indignify  
He/She/It will indignify      They will indignify

**Indignify in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be indignifying      We will be indignifying  
You will be indignifying      You will be indignifying  
He/She/It will be indignifying      They will be indignifying

**Indignify in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will have indignified**                      We **will have indignified**  
You **will have indignified**                You **will have indignified**  
He/She/It **will have indignified**      They **will have indignified**

**Indignify in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will have been indignifying**                We **will have been indignifying**  
You **will have been indignifying**            You **will have been indignifying**  
He/She/It **will have been indignifying**    They **will have been indignifying**
