Utterly bewildering or perplexing.

A mystifying phenomenon.

**perplexing**Lacking clarity of meaning; causing confusion or perplexity.

A **perplexing** problem.

Lacking clarity of meaning; causing confusion or perplexity.

A **puzzling** statement.

**strange** Slightly or undefinably unwell or ill at ease.

*It is* **strange** how things change.

Unable to be explained.

**unaccountable** He was not only the most charismatic man she d ever met but also the

most complex and unaccountable.

unexplainable Unable to be explained or accounted for.

An **unexplainable** fear.

unfathomable (of water or a natural feature) impossible to measure the extent of.

Her grey eyes were dark with some **unfathomable** emotion.

Not easily solved.

**unsolvable** Public finance had long presented problems **unsolvable** or at least

unsolved.

Strikingly odd or unusual.

weird A weird coincidence.
