## Associations of "Inextricably" (30 Words)

<b><u>affiliated</u></b>	Being joined in close association. <i><b>Affiliated</b> clubs.</i>
<b>attached</b>	Joined, fastened, or connected to something. <i>A science policy agency <b>attached</b> to the Council of Ministers.</i>
<b><u>bind</u></b>	Provide with a binding. <i>The Chinese would <b>bind</b> the feet of their women.</i>
<b>bond</b>	Criminal law money that must be forfeited by the bondsman if an accused person fails to appear in court for trial. <i>English <b>bond</b>.</i>
<b><u>closely</u></b>	In a collective or unified way. <i>The students had to answer questions <b>closely</b> related to what they just learned.</i>
<b>connect</b>	Connect fasten or put together two or more pieces. <i>Can you <b>connect</b> the two loudspeakers.</i>
<b>connected</b>	Joined or linked together. <i>First check to see whether the appliance is <b>connected</b>.</i>
<b>connection</b>	A relationship in which a person or thing is linked or associated with something else. <i>He had <b>connections</b> in the music industry.</i>
<b><u>correlated</u></b>	Mutually related.
<b>correlative</b>	Expressing a reciprocal or complementary relation. <i>Rights whether moral or legal can involve <b>correlative</b> duties.</i>
<b>corresponding</b>	Conforming in every respect. <i>All rights carry with them <b>corresponding</b> responsibilities.</i>
<b>embroil</b>	Force into some kind of situation, condition, or course of action. <i>The film s about a journalist who becomes <b>embroiled</b> with a nightclub owner.</i>

<b>entangle</b>	Entrap. <i>Fish attempt to swim through the mesh and become <b>entangled</b>.</i>
<b>included</b>	Enclosed in the same envelope or package. <i>The <b>included</b> check.</i>
<b>interconnect</b>	Cause to be interconnected or interwoven. <i>The bones are <b>interconnected</b> via the muscle.</i>
<b><u>interdependent</u></b>	(of two or more people or things) dependent on each other. <i>We in Europe are all increasingly <b>interdependent</b>.</i>
<b>interlinear</b>	(of a book) having the same text in different languages printed on alternate lines. <i>A Greek English <b>interlinear</b> New Testament.</i>
<b>intimately</b>	In a way that involves a close link or relationship. <i>The two phenomena are <b>intimately</b> connected.</i>
<b><u>involvement</u></b>	The fact or condition of being involved with or participating in something. <i>There was additional <b>involvement</b> of the liver and spleen.</i>
<b>knot</b>	Make into knots make knots out of. <i>His stomach was in <b>knots</b>.</i>
<b><u>link</u></b>	The means of connection between things linked in series. <i>The walls are held together with metal <b>links</b> placed in the wet mortar during construction.</i>
<b>linked</b>	Connected by a link, as railway cars or trailer trucks.
<b>nexus</b>	A connected group or series. <i>A <b>nexus</b> of ideas.</i>
<b>ravel</b>	Untangle or unravel something. <i>A <b>ravel</b> of knitting.</i>
<b>related</b>	Connected by kinship, common origin, or marriage. <i>Income <b>related</b> benefits.</i>
<b><u>relatively</u></b>	Regarded in comparison with something else rather than absolutely; quite. <i>The situation is <b>relatively</b> calm now.</i>
<b><u>tangle</u></b>	Tangle or complicate. <i>A ploy to <b>tangle</b> matters even further.</i>
<b><u>tie</u></b>	Unite musical notes by a tie. <i>It is important that we keep family <b>ties</b> strong.</i>
<b>underbrush</b>	The brush (small trees and bushes and ferns etc.) growing beneath taller trees in a wood or forest.
