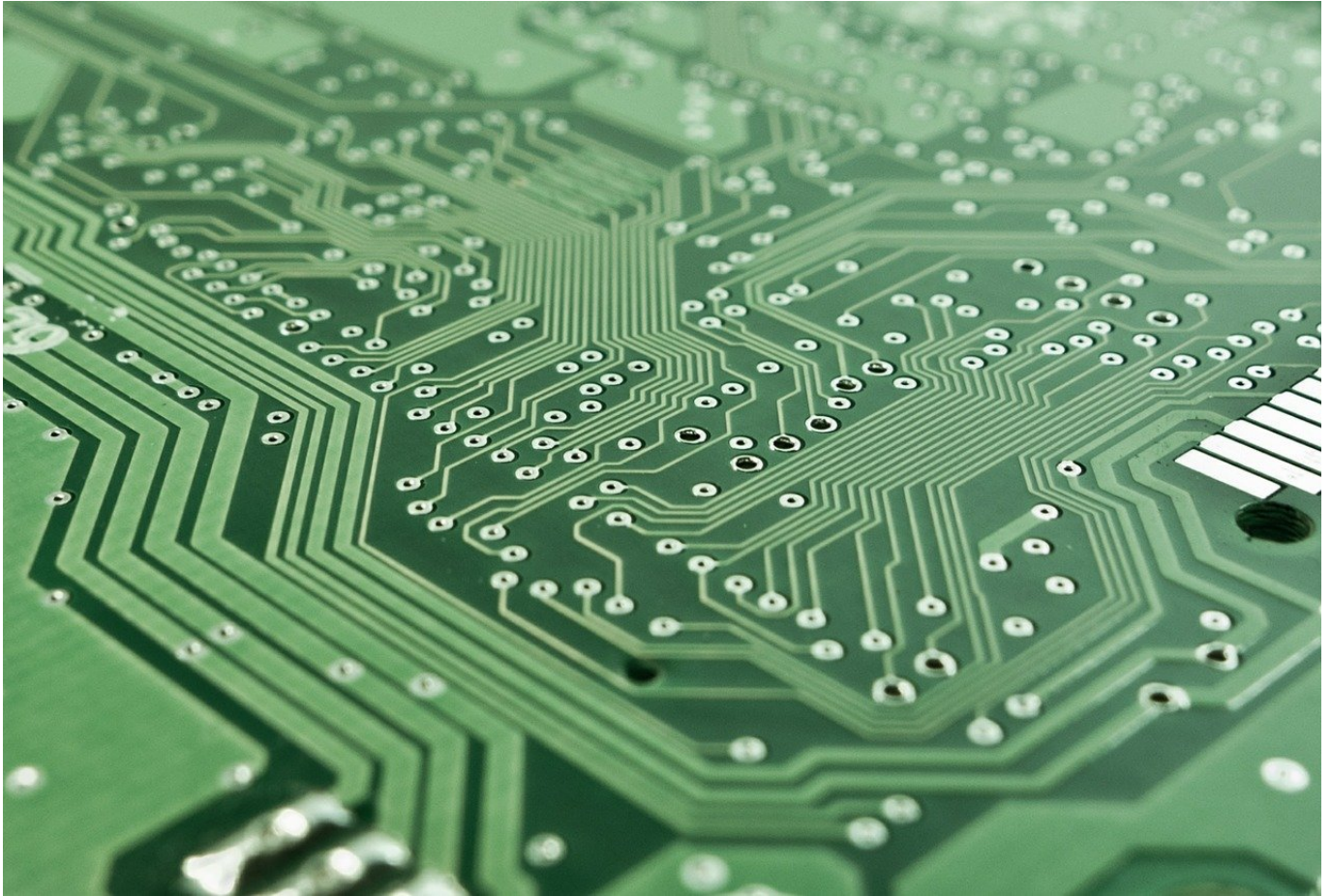

Definitions of "Informant" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “informant” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Someone who sees an event and reports what happened.*
- *A person who gives information to another.*
- *A person from whom a linguist or anthropologist obtains information about language, dialect, or culture.*
- *A person who supplies information.*



Synonyms of "Informant" as a noun (5 Words)

- authority** An administrative unit of government.
*He was an **authority** on the stock market.*
- reference** A person who agrees to testify to someone's ability or reliability when they apply for a new job.
*A **reference** work.*
- source** A document (or organization) from which information is obtained.
*A heat **source**.*
- witness** Someone who sees an event and reports what happened.
*They will be able to give **witness** of their faith and confidence in God.*
- witnesser** Someone who sees an event and reports what happened.
