Infinitive	to infuriate
Present Tense	infuriate / infuriates
Past Tense	infuriated
Present Participle	infuriating
Past Participle	infuriated

Conjugate Infuriate

Infuriate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **infuriate** We **infuriate**
You **infuriate** You **infuriate**
He/She/It **infuriates** They **infuriate**

Infuriate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am infuriating** We **are infuriating**
You **are infuriating** You **are infuriating**
He/She/It **is infuriating** They **are infuriating**

Infuriate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have infuriated** We **have infuriated**
You **have infuriated** You **have infuriated**
He/She/It **has infuriated** They **have infuriated**

Infuriate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been infuriating** We **have been infuriating**
You **have been infuriating** You **have been infuriating**
He/She/It **has been infuriating** They **have been infuriating**

Infuriate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **infuriated** We **infuriated**
You **infuriated** You **infuriated**
He/She/It **infuriated** They **infuriated**

Infuriate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was infuriating We were infuriating
You were infuriating You were infuriating
He/She/It was infuriating They were infuriating

Infuriate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had infuriated We had infuriated
You had infuriated You had infuriated
He/She/It had infuriated They had infuriated

Infuriate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been infuriating We had been infuriating
You had been infuriating You had been infuriating
He/She/It had been infuriating They had been infuriating

Infuriate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will infuriate We will infuriate
You will infuriate You will infuriate
He/She/It will infuriate They will infuriate

Infuriate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be infuriating We will be infuriating
You will be infuriating You will be infuriating
He/She/It will be infuriating They will be infuriating

Infuriate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have infuriated

We will have infuriated

You will have infuriated

You will have infuriated

He/She/It will have infuriated

They will have infuriated

Infuriate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been infuriating

We will have been infuriating

You will have been infuriating

You will have been infuriating

He/She/It will have been infuriating

They will have been infuriating
