# **Conjugate Ingeniate**

#### **Ingeniate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>ingeniate</b>	We <b>ingeniate</b>
You <b>ingeniate</b>	You <b>ingeniate</b>
He/She/It ingeniates	They <b>ingeniate</b>

## **Ingeniate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am ingeniating	We are ingeniating
You <b>are ingeniating</b>	You are ingeniating
He/She/It is ingeniating	They are ingeniating

## **Ingeniate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have ingeniated	We have ingeniated
You <b>have ingeniated</b>	You have ingeniated
He/She/It has ingeniated	They have ingeniated

## **Ingeniate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been ingeniating	We <b>have been ingeniating</b>
You <b>have been ingeniating</b>	You <b>have been ingeniating</b>
He/She/It has been ingeniating	They have been ingeniating

## **Ingeniate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I ingeniated	We <b>ingeniated</b>
You <b>ingeniated</b>	You <b>ingeniated</b>
He/She/It ingeniated	They <b>ingeniated</b>

#### **Ingeniate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was ingeniating	We were ingeniating
You <b>were ingeniating</b>	You were ingeniating
He/She/It was ingeniating	They were ingeniating

## **Ingeniate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had ingeniated	We had ingeniated
You <b>had ingeniated</b>	You had ingeniated
He/She/It had ingeniated	They had ingeniated

## **Ingeniate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been ingeniating	We <b>had been ingeniating</b>
You <b>had been ingeniating</b>	You had been ingeniating
He/She/It had been ingeniating	They had been ingeniating

## **Ingeniate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will ingeniate	We <b>will ingeniate</b>
You <b>will ingeniate</b>	You <b>will ingeniate</b>
He/She/It will ingeniate	They <b>will ingeniate</b>

## **Ingeniate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be ingeniating	We will be ingeniating
You <b>will be ingeniating</b>	You will be ingeniating
He/She/It will be ingeniating	They will be ingeniating
