## The Forms of Injoin

Infinitive	<b>to injoin</b>
Present Tense	<b>injoin / injoins</b>
Past Tense	<b>injoined</b>
Present Participle	<b>injoining</b>
Past Participle	<b>injoined</b>

## Conjugate Injoin

**Injoin in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **injoin**                  We **injoin**  
You **injoin**              You **injoin**  
He/She/It **injoins**    They **injoin**

**Injoin in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **am injoining**        We **are injoining**  
You **are injoining**    You **are injoining**  
He/She/It **is injoining** They **are injoining**

**Injoin in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have injoined**        We **have injoined**  
You **have injoined**    You **have injoined**  
He/She/It **has injoined** They **have injoined**

**Injoin in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have been injoining**    We **have been injoining**  
You **have been injoining**    You **have been injoining**  
He/She/It **has been injoining** They **have been injoining**

**Injoin in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **injoined**              We **injoined**  
You **injoined**            You **injoined**  
He/She/It **injoined**    They **injoined**

**Injoin in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was **injoining**                      We were **injoining**  
You were **injoining**                You were **injoining**  
He/She/It was **injoining**        They were **injoining**

**Injoin in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had **injoined**                        We had **injoined**  
You had **injoined**                    You had **injoined**  
He/She/It had **injoined**        They had **injoined**

**Injoin in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been **injoining**                We had been **injoining**  
You had been **injoining**            You had been **injoining**  
He/She/It had been **injoining**    They had been **injoining**

**Injoin in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will **injoin**                            We will **injoin**  
You will **injoin**                        You will **injoin**  
He/She/It will **injoin**                They will **injoin**

**Injoin in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be **injoining**                    We will be **injoining**  
You will be **injoining**                You will be **injoining**  
He/She/It will be **injoining**        They will be **injoining**

**Injoin in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have injoined**

**We will have injoined**

**You will have injoined**

**You will have injoined**

**He/She/It will have injoined**

**They will have injoined**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been injoining**

**We will have been injoining**

**You will have been injoining**

**You will have been injoining**

**He/She/It will have been injoining**

**They will have been injoining**
