## **Conjugate Injury**

#### **Injury in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>injury</b>	We <b>injury</b>
You <b>injury</b>	You <b>injury</b>
He/She/It <b>injuries</b>	They <b>injury</b>

## **Injury in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am injurying	We <b>are injurying</b>
You <b>are injurying</b>	You <b>are injurying</b>
He/She/It is injurying	They are injurying

### **Injury in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have injuried	We have injuried
You <b>have injuried</b>	You have injuried
He/She/It has injuried	They have injuried

## **Injury in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been injurying	We have been injurying
You <b>have been injurying</b>	You have been injurying
He/She/It has been injurying	They have been injurying

## **Injury in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>injuried</b>	We <b>injuried</b>
You <b>injuried</b>	You <b>injuried</b>
He/She/It injuried	They <b>injuried</b>

#### **Injury in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was injurying	We <b>were injurying</b>
You <b>were injurying</b>	You were injurying
He/She/It was injurying	They were injurying

### **Injury in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had injuried	We had injuried
You <b>had injuried</b>	You <b>had injuried</b>
He/She/It had injuried	They had injuried

### **Injury in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been injurying	We had been injurying
You <b>had been injurying</b>	You <b>had been injurying</b>
He/She/It had been injurying	They had been injurying

## **Injury in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will injury	We <b>will injury</b>
You <b>will injury</b>	You <b>will injury</b>
He/She/It will injury	They will injury

## **Injury in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be injurying	We <b>will be injurying</b>
You <b>will be injurying</b>	You <b>will be injurying</b>
He/She/It will be injurying	They will be injurying

I will have been injurying	We <b>will have been injurying</b>
You <b>will have been injurying</b>	You <b>will have been injurying</b>
He/She/It will have been injurying	They will have been injurying
