# **Conjugate Inlay**

### Inlay in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>inlay</b>	We <b>inlay</b>
You <b>inlay</b>	You <b>inlay</b>
He/She/It inlays	They <b>inlay</b>

### **Inlay in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am inlaying	We <b>are inlaying</b>
You <b>are inlaying</b>	You <b>are inlaying</b>
He/She/It is inlaying	They <b>are inlaying</b>

### **Inlay in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have inlaid	We have inlaid
You <b>have inlaid</b>	You <b>have inlaid</b>
He/She/It has inlaid	They have inlaid

# **Inlay in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been inlaying	We have been inlaying
You <b>have been inlaying</b>	You have been inlaying
He/She/It has been inlaying	They have been inlaying

# Inlay in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>inlaid</b>	We <b>inlaid</b>
You <b>inlaid</b>	You <b>inlaid</b>
He/She/It <b>inlaid</b>	They <b>inlaid</b>

#### **Inlay in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was inlaying	We <b>were inlaying</b>
You <b>were inlaying</b>	You <b>were inlaying</b>
He/She/It was inlaying	They were inlaying

### **Inlay in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had inlaid	We <b>had inlaid</b>
You <b>had inlaid</b>	You <b>had inlaid</b>
He/She/It had inlaid	They had inlaid

### **Inlay in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been inlaying	We had been inlaying
You <b>had been inlaying</b>	You had been inlaying
He/She/It had been inlaying	They had been inlaying

# Inlay in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will inlay	We <b>will inlay</b>
You <b>will inlay</b>	You <b>will inlay</b>
He/She/It will inlay They will inlay	

# **Inlay in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be inlaying	We will be inlaying
You <b>will be inlaying</b>	You <b>will be inlaying</b>
He/She/It will be inlaying	They will be inlaying

# **Inlay in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

I will have been inlaying	We <b>will have been inlaying</b>
You <b>will have been inlaying</b>	You <b>will have been inlaying</b>
He/She/It will have been inlaying	They will have been inlaying
