Present Tense	<b>innervate / innervates</b>
Past Tense	<b>innervated</b>
Present Participle	<b>innervating</b>
Past Participle	<b>innervated</b>

## Conjugate Innervate

**Innervate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **innervate**  
You **innervate**  
He/She/It **innervates** They **innervate**

**Innervate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am innervating**  
You **are innervating**  
He/She/It **is innervating** They **are innervating**

**Innervate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have innervated**  
You **have innervated**  
He/She/It **has innervated** They **have innervated**

**Innervate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **have been innervating**  
You **have been innervating**  
He/She/It **has been innervating** They **have been innervating**

**Innervate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I <b>was innervating</b>	We <b>were innervating</b>
You <b>were innervating</b>	You <b>were innervating</b>
He/She/It <b>was innervating</b>	They <b>were innervating</b>

**Innervate in Past Perfect Tense**

I <b>had innervated</b>	We <b>had innervated</b>
You <b>had innervated</b>	You <b>had innervated</b>
He/She/It <b>had innervated</b>	They <b>had innervated</b>

**Innervate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>had been innervating</b>	We <b>had been innervating</b>
You <b>had been innervating</b>	You <b>had been innervating</b>
He/She/It <b>had been innervating</b>	They <b>had been innervating</b>

**Innervate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I <b>will innervate</b>	We <b>will innervate</b>
You <b>will innervate</b>	You <b>will innervate</b>
He/She/It <b>will innervate</b>	They <b>will innervate</b>

**Innervate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I <b>will be innervating</b>	We <b>will be innervating</b>
You <b>will be innervating</b>	You <b>will be innervating</b>
He/She/It <b>will be innervating</b>	They <b>will be innervating</b>

**Innervate in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have innervated**

**We will have innervated**

**You will have innervated**

**You will have innervated**

**He/She/It will have innervated**

**They will have innervated**

**I will have been innervating**

**We will have been innervating**

**You will have been innervating**

**You will have been innervating**

**He/She/It will have been innervating**

**They will have been innervating**
