# **Conjugate Inorganize**

## **Inorganize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>inorganize</b>	We <b>inorganize</b>
You <b>inorganize</b>	You <b>inorganize</b>
He/She/It inorganizes	They <b>inorganize</b>

## **Inorganize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am inorganizing	We are inorganizing
You <b>are inorganizing</b>	You <b>are inorganizing</b>
He/She/It is inorganizing	They are inorganizing

#### **Inorganize in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have inorganized	We have inorganized
You have inorganized	You have inorganized
He/She/It has inorganized	They have inorganized

## **Inorganize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been inorganizing	We have been inorganizing
You <b>have been inorganizing</b>	You have been inorganizing
He/She/It has been inorganizing	They have been inorganizing

## **Inorganize in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>inorganized</b>	We <b>inorganized</b>
You <b>inorganized</b>	You <b>inorganized</b>
He/She/It inorganized	They <b>inorganized</b>

#### **Inorganize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was inorganizing	We <b>were inorganizing</b>
You <b>were inorganizing</b>	You <b>were inorganizing</b>
He/She/It was inorganizing	They were inorganizing

## **Inorganize in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had inorganized	We had inorganized
You <b>had inorganized</b>	You had inorganized
He/She/It had inorganized	They had inorganized

#### **Inorganize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been inorganizing	We <b>had been inorganizing</b>
You <b>had been inorganizing</b>	You <b>had been inorganizing</b>
He/She/It had been inorganizing	They had been inorganizing

## **Inorganize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will inorganize	We <b>will inorganize</b>
You <b>will inorganize</b>	You <b>will inorganize</b>
He/She/It will inorganize	They <b>will inorganize</b>

## **Inorganize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be inorganizing	We <b>will be inorganizing</b>
You <b>will be inorganizing</b>	You <b>will be inorganizing</b>
He/She/It will be inorganizing	They will be inorganizing

I will have been inorganizing	We <b>will have been inorganizing</b>

He/She/It will have been inorganizing	They will have been inorganizing
