Past Tense	inquisitioned
Present Participle	inquisitioning
Past Participle	inquisitioned

Inquisition in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I inquisition	We inquisition
You inquisition	You inquisition
He/She/It inquisitions	They inquisition

Inquisition in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am inquisitioning	We are inquisitioning
You are inquisitioning	You are inquisitioning
He/She/It is inquisitioning	They are inquisitioning

Inquisition in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have inquisitioned	We have inquisitioned
You have inquisitioned	You have inquisitioned
He/She/It has inquisitioned	They have inquisitioned

Inquisition in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been inquisitioning	We have been inquisitioning
You have been inquisitioning	You have been inquisitioning
He/She/It has been inquisitioning	They have been inquisitioning

Inquisition in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I inquisitioned	We inquisitioned
You inquisitioned	You inquisitioned
He/She/It inquisitioned	They inquisitioned

Inquisition in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was inquisitioning	We were inquisitioning
You were inquisitioning	You were inquisitioning
He/She/It was inquisitioning	They were inquisitioning

Inquisition in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had inquisitioned	We had inquisitioned
You had inquisitioned	You had inquisitioned
He/She/It had inquisitioned	They had inquisitioned

Inquisition in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been inquisitioning	We had been inquisitioning
You had been inquisitioning	You had been inquisitioning
He/She/It had been inquisitioning	They had been inquisitioning

Inquisition in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will inquisition	We will inquisition
You will inquisition	You will inquisition
He/She/It will inquisition	They will inquisition

Inquisition in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be inquisitioning	We will be inquisitioning
You will be inquisitioning	You will be inquisitioning
He/She/It will be inquisitioning	They will be inquisitioning
