## Associations of "Ins and outs" (30 Words)

<a href="#">away</a>	An away match or win. <i>They walked <b>away</b> from the vicarage in silence.</i>
<b>baseboard</b>	A molding covering the joint formed by a wall and the floor.
<a href="#">distant</a>	(after a measurement) at a specified distance. <i>The sound of <b>distant</b> traffic.</i>
<b>domesticity</b>	The quality of being domestic or domesticated. <i>The atmosphere is one of happy <b>domesticity</b>.</i>
<a href="#">external</a>	Coming from or relating to a country or institution other than the main subject. <i>The <b>external</b> walls.</i>
<a href="#">extrinsic</a>	(of a muscle, such as an eye muscle) having its origin some distance from the part which it moves. <i>A complex interplay of <b>extrinsic</b> and intrinsic factors.</i>
<a href="#">facing</a>	An outer layer covering the surface of a wall. <i>Two <b>facing</b> pages.</i>
<b>furnishing</b>	Denoting fabrics used for curtains or upholstery. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious <b>furnishings</b>.</i>
<a href="#">gym</a>	Gymnastics. <i>I can t do <b>gym</b> today.</i>
<b>indoor</b>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i><b>Indoor</b> activities for a rainy day.</i>
<b>indoors</b>	Within a building. <i>The rain makes <b>indoors</b> feel so warm and safe.</i>
<b>inland</b>	Towards or into the interior of a region. <i>The path turned <b>inland</b> and met the road.</i>
<b>inmost</b>	Being deepest within the self.

<b>inner</b>	Innermost or essential. <i>A test of <b>inner</b> strength.</i>
<b>inside</b>	On the inside. <i>Wipe the <b>inside</b> of the windscreen.</i>
<b>insider</b>	A person within a group or organization, especially someone privy to information unavailable to others. <i>Political <b>insiders</b>.</i>
<b>interior</b>	Remote from the coast or frontier; inland. <i>She thinks she has no soul no <b>interior</b> life but the truth is that she has no access to it.</i>
<b><u>internal</u></b>	Experienced in one's mind; inner rather than expressed. <i>The nation s <b>internal</b> politics.</i>
<b>intramural</b>	Situated within the wall of a hollow organ or a cell. <i>Recreational <b>intramural</b> games.</i>
<b>inward</b>	Directed or moving inward or toward a center. <i><b>Inward</b> mail.</i>
<b>inwardly</b>	With respect to private feelings. <i><b>Inwardly</b> she was raging.</i>
<b>lining</b>	The act of attaching an inside lining to a garment or curtain etc. <i>Leather gloves with fur <b>linings</b>.</i>
<b><u>outside</u></b>	The region that is outside of something. <i>An <b>outside</b> margin.</i>
<b>outward</b>	Outwards. <i>An <b>outward</b> display of friendliness.</i>
<b><u>reclusive</u></b>	Avoiding the company of other people; solitary. <i>He led a <b>reclusive</b> life.</i>
<b>redecorate</b>	Redo the decoration of an apartment or house. <i>You will have to <b>redecorate</b> the room afterwards.</i>
<b><u>reserved</u></b>	Marked by self-restraint and reticence. <i>He is a <b>reserved</b> almost taciturn man.</i>
<b>therein</b>	In that place, document, or respect. <i>It shall be sufficient evidence of the facts <b>therein</b> contained.</i>
<b>upstage</b>	Move upstage forcing the other actors to turn away from the audience. <i>Hamlet turns to face <b>upstage</b>.</i>
<b>within</b>	On the inside. <i>Enquire <b>within</b>.</i>
