away	An away match or win. <i>They walked away from the vicarage in silence.</i>
baseboard	A molding covering the joint formed by a wall and the floor.
distant	(after a measurement) at a specified distance. <i>The sound of distant traffic.</i>
domesticity	The quality of being domestic or domesticated. <i>The atmosphere is one of happy domesticity.</i>
external	Coming from or relating to a country or institution other than the main subject. <i>The external walls.</i>
extrinsic	(of a muscle, such as an eye muscle) having its origin some distance from the part which it moves. <i>A complex interplay of extrinsic and intrinsic factors.</i>
facing	An outer layer covering the surface of a wall. <i>Two facing pages.</i>
furnishing	Denoting fabrics used for curtains or upholstery. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings.</i>
gym	Gymnastics. <i>I can t do gym today.</i>
indoor	Relating to sports played indoors. <i>Indoor activities for a rainy day.</i>
indoors	Within a building. <i>The rain makes indoors feel so warm and safe.</i>
inland	Towards or into the interior of a region. <i>The path turned inland and met the road.</i>
inmost	Being deepest within the self.

inner	Innermost or essential. <i>A test of inner strength.</i>
inside	On the inside. <i>Wipe the inside of the windscreen.</i>
insider	A person within a group or organization, especially someone privy to information unavailable to others. <i>Political insiders.</i>
interior	Remote from the coast or frontier; inland. <i>She thinks she has no soul no interior life but the truth is that she has no access to it.</i>
<u>internal</u>	Experienced in one's mind; inner rather than expressed. <i>The nation s internal politics.</i>
intramural	Situated within the wall of a hollow organ or a cell. <i>Recreational intramural games.</i>
inward	Directed or moving inward or toward a center. <i>Inward mail.</i>
inwardly	With respect to private feelings. <i>Inwardly she was raging.</i>
lining	The act of attaching an inside lining to a garment or curtain etc. <i>Leather gloves with fur linings.</i>
<u>outside</u>	The region that is outside of something. <i>An outside margin.</i>
outward	Outwards. <i>An outward display of friendliness.</i>
<u>reclusive</u>	Avoiding the company of other people; solitary. <i>He led a reclusive life.</i>
redecorate	Redo the decoration of an apartment or house. <i>You will have to redecorate the room afterwards.</i>
<u>reserved</u>	Marked by self-restraint and reticence. <i>He is a reserved almost taciturn man.</i>
therein	In that place, document, or respect. <i>It shall be sufficient evidence of the facts therein contained.</i>
upstage	Move upstage forcing the other actors to turn away from the audience. <i>Hamlet turns to face upstage.</i>
within	On the inside. <i>Enquire within.</i>
