In an insane manner. dementedly Screaming **dementedly**. Extremely (used as intensives. deucedly They re **deucedly** hard to find. As a devil; in an evil manner. devilishly The socialists are further handicapped if they believe that capitalists are not only wicked but also **devilishly** clever.

<u>bipolar</u>	Of a person suffering from bipolar disorder. <i>Bipolar species.</i>
certifiable	Capable of being guaranteed or certified. A <i>certifiable fact</i> .
crazy	Extremely. I ve been crazy busy.
<u>daft</u>	Infatuated with. Don t ask such daft questions.
demented	Affected with madness or insanity. She was demented with worry.
<u>deranged</u>	Driven insane. A deranged gunman.



disturbed	Affected with madness or insanity. The disturbed books and papers on her desk.
epilepsy	A disorder of the central nervous system characterized by loss of consciousness and convulsions.
folly	Lack of good sense; foolishness. An act of sheer folly .
frenetic	Fast and energetic in a rather wild and uncontrolled way. <i>Frenetic</i> screams followed the accident.
<u>frenzy</u>	A state or period of uncontrolled excitement or wild behaviour. Doreen worked herself into a frenzy of rage.
<u>hysteria</u>	Excessive or uncontrollable fear. The anti Semitic hysteria of the 1890s.
<u>hysterical</u>	Characterized by or arising from psychoneurotic hysteria- Morris Fishbein. A mob of hysterical vigilantes.
<u>insanity</u>	Extreme foolishness or irrationality. <i>He suffered from bouts of insanity.</i>
<u>lunatic</u>	Extremely foolish or eccentric. A ward of lunatic old ladies.
mad	Make someone mad. She pictured loved ones mad with anxiety about her.
madden	Drive (someone or something) insane. This is ridiculous she told him madden ed by his reaction.
mania	Mental illness marked by periods of great excitement or euphoria, delusions, and overactivity. <i>He had a mania for automobiles.</i>
mentally	In your mind. Soldiers become physically and mentally exhausted.
<u>neurotic</u>	A neurotic person. I wasn t going to be labelled as a hypochondriac or neurotic .
nuts	Mad. The way he turns on the television as soon as he walks in drives me nuts .
<u>paranoia</u>	Unjustified suspicion and mistrust of other people. Mild paranoia afflicts all prime ministers.
<u>paranoid</u>	A person who is paranoid. Further accusations would sound like the ramblings of a paranoid .



<u>psychopath</u>	Someone with a sociopathic personality a person with an antisocial personality disorder psychopath was once widely used but has now been superseded by sociopath. Playground psychopaths will gather around a fight to encourage the combatants.
psychosis	A severe mental disorder in which thought and emotions are so impaired that contact is lost with external reality. They were suffering from a psychosis .
<u>rabid</u>	Of or connected with rabies. The show s small but rabid fan base.
raving	In a raving manner. The raving s of a madwoman.
schizophrenia	A long-term mental disorder of a type involving a breakdown in the relation between thought, emotion, and behaviour, leading to faulty perception, inappropriate actions and feelings, withdrawal from reality and personal relationships into fantasy and delusion, and a sense of mental fragmentation. <i>Gibraltar s schizophrenia</i> continues to be fed by colonial pride.
<u>simpleton</u>	A foolish or gullible person. Stop grinning at me like a simpleton .
unbalanced	Debits and credits are not equal. This may give an unbalanced impression of the competition.
