Institutionalise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I institutionalise We institutionalise
You institutionalise You institutionalise
He/She/It institutionalises They institutionalise

Institutionalise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am institutionalising We are institutionalising
You are institutionalising You are institutionalising
He/She/It is institutionalising They are institutionalising

Institutionalise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have institutionalised We have institutionalised You have institutionalised He/She/It has institutionalised They have institutionalised

Institutionalise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been institutionalising
You have been institutionalising
He/She/It has been institutionalising
They have been institutionalising

Institutionalise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I institutionalised We institutionalised
You institutionalised You institutionalised
He/She/It institutionalised They institutionalised

Institutionalise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was institutionalising We were institutionalising You were institutionalising He/She/It was institutionalising They were institutionalising

Institutionalise in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had institutionalised We had institutionalised You had institutionalised He/She/It had institutionalised They had institutionalised

Institutionalise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been institutionalising
You had been institutionalising
He/She/It had been institutionalising
They had been institutionalising

Institutionalise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will institutionalise
You will institutionalise
He/She/It will institutionalise
They will institutionalise

Institutionalise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be institutionalising
You will be institutionalising
He/She/It will be institutionalising
They will be institutionalising

Institutionalise in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have institutionalised We will have institutionalised You will have institutionalised He/She/It will have institutionalised They will have institutionalised

Institutionalise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been institutionalising
You will have been institutionalising
He/She/It will have been institutionalising
They will have been institutionalising
