## Associations of "Interacting" (30 Words)

<a href="#">acquaint</a>	Make familiar or conversant with. <i>You should <b>acquaint</b> yourself with your new computer.</i>
<b>address</b>	Address or apply oneself to something direct one's efforts towards something such as a question. <i><b>Address</b> your complaints to the Trading Standards Board.</i>
<a href="#">bulletin</a>	Make public by bulletin.
<b>colloquial</b>	Characteristic of informal spoken language or conversation. <i>Wrote her letters in a <b>colloquial</b> style.</i>
<b>colloquialism</b>	The use of colloquialisms. <i>The <b>colloquialisms</b> of the streets.</i>
<b>communicate</b>	Transmit (heat or motion). <i>The rooms <b>communicated</b>.</i>
<b>communication</b>	A letter or message containing information or news. <i>Satellite <b>communications</b>.</i>
<a href="#">confer</a>	Have a conference in order to talk something over. <i>The Minister may have exceeded the powers <b>conferred</b> on him by Parliament.</i>
<a href="#">convey</a>	Transfer the title to (property). <i>She <b>conveyed</b> the message to me.</i>
<a href="#">cooperatively</a>	In a way that involves mutual assistance in working towards a common goal. <i>A <b>cooperatively</b> owned restaurant.</i>
<a href="#">correspondence</a>	Similarity by virtue of corresponding. <i>His wife dealt with his private <b>correspondence</b>.</i>
<b>delivery</b>	The supply or provision of something. <i>She had a difficult <b>delivery</b>.</i>

<b>email</b>	A message sent by email. <i>Reading <b>email</b> has become the first task of the morning.</i>
<b>ferry</b>	Transport by ferry. <i>Ambulances <b>ferried</b> the injured to hospital.</i>
<b>informing</b>	To furnish incriminating evidence to an officer of the law (usually in return for favors.
<b>message</b>	Send as a message. <i>I was <b>messaged</b> by a Californian contact for some information.</i>
<b>persuasively</b>	In a persuasive or convincing manner. <i>He argues <b>persuasively</b> against nationalism.</i>
<b>post</b>	Publicize with or as if with a poster. <i>A pair of <b>posts</b> marked the goal.</i>
<b>recitative</b>	Musical declamation of the kind usual in the narrative and dialogue parts of opera and oratorio, sung in the rhythm of ordinary speech with many words on the same note. <i>Singing in <b>recitative</b>.</i>
<a href="#">relay</a>	Control or operate by relay. <i>The wagons were pulled by <b>relays</b> of horses.</i>
<b>report</b>	Cover an event or subject as a journalist or a reporter. <i>Police <b>reported</b> that the floods were abating.</i>
<a href="#">respond</a>	Respond favorably or as hoped. <i>To partner s opening one heart it is dangerous to <b>respond</b> two clubs.</i>
<b>send</b>	Send a message or letter. <i><b>Send</b> me your latest results.</i>
<b>sender</b>	Someone who transmits a message. <i>Evidence submitted late will be returned to the <b>sender</b>.</i>
<b>spam</b>	Unwanted or intrusive advertising on the internet. <i>An autogenerated <b>spam</b> website.</i>
<b>telegraphic</b>	Of or relating to or transmitted by telegraph. <i>The strange <b>telegraphic</b> speech of some aphasics.</i>
<a href="#">transmit</a>	Transmit or serve as the medium for transmission. <i><b>Transmit</b> a message.</i>
<b>transport</b>	Something that serves as a means of transportation. <i>The bulk of freight traffic was <b>transported</b> by lorry.</i>
<b>verbally</b>	With the function of a verb. <i>She claimed to have been <b>verbally</b> abused.</i>
