Infinitive	to intermediate
Present Tense	intermediate / intermediates
Past Tense	intermediated
Present Participle	intermediating
Past Participle	intermediated

# **Conjugate Intermediate**

### **Intermediate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I intermediate	We <b>intermediate</b>
You <b>intermediate</b>	You <b>intermediate</b>
He/She/It intermediates	They <b>intermediate</b>

## **Intermediate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am intermediating	We are intermediating
You <b>are intermediating</b>	You are intermediating
He/She/It is intermediating	They are intermediating

#### **Intermediate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have intermediated	We have intermediated
You have intermediated	You have intermediated
He/She/It has intermediated	They have intermediated

### **Intermediate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been intermediating	We have been intermediating
You have been intermediating	You have been intermediating
He/She/It has been intermediating	They have been intermediating

# **Intermediate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I intermediated	We <b>intermediated</b>
You intermediated	You <b>intermediated</b>
He/She/It intermediated	They <b>intermediated</b>

#### **Intermediate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was intermediating	We were intermediating
You were intermediating	You were intermediating
He/She/It was intermediating	They were intermediating

#### **Intermediate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had intermediated	We had intermediated
You <b>had intermediated</b>	You had intermediated
He/She/It had intermediated	They had intermediated

#### **Intermediate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been intermediating	We had been intermediating
You had been intermediating	You had been intermediating
He/She/It had been intermediating	They had been intermediating

# **Intermediate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will intermediate	We will intermediate
You <b>will intermediate</b>	You <b>will intermediate</b>
He/She/It will intermediate	They will intermediate

## Intermediate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be intermediating	We <b>will be intermediating</b>
You <b>will be intermediating</b>	You <b>will be intermediating</b>
He/She/It will be intermediating	They will be intermediating

### **Intermediate in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have intermediatedWe will have intermediatedYou will have intermediatedYou will have intermediatedHe/She/It will have intermediatedThey will have intermediated

### **Intermediate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been intermediating	We will have been intermediating
You <b>will have been intermediating</b>	You will have been intermediating
He/She/It will have been intermediating	They will have been intermediating
