- *Happening or arising or located within some limits or especially surface.*

- *Innermost or essential.*
- *Of the inner nature of a thing; intrinsic.*
- *Inside the body.*

civil	Relating to civil law. <i>They try to work out their differences in a civil manner.</i>
domestic	Converted or adapted to domestic use. <i>Domestic issues such as tax rate and highway construction.</i>
emotional	Excessively affected by emotion. <i>Gaining emotional support from relatives.</i>
home	Made done or intended for use in the home. <i>Home fans.</i>
inner	Innermost or essential. <i>Inner circles of government.</i>
inside	Situated on or in the inside. <i>Inside out.</i>
interior	Inside and toward a center. <i>The interior minister.</i>
intimate	(of knowledge) detailed or thorough. <i>This girl so intimate with nature.</i>
intragroup	Occurring within an institution or community. <i>Intragroup squabbling within the corporation.</i>

- intramural** Situated or done within a community.
*Recreational **intramural** games.*
- local** Of or belonging to or characteristic of a particular locality or neighborhood.
*The village has an excellent **local** bus service.*
- mental** Of or relating to the chin- or liplike structure in insects and certain mollusks.
*I think he was a little worried that I might be **mental**.*
- national** Of or relating to nationality.
***National** forests.*
- native** Used in names of animals or plants resembling others familiar elsewhere e.g native bee.
*The **native** North American sugar maple.*
- psychological** Relating to psychology.
*It was concluded that her pain was **psychological**.*

disembodied	Separated from or existing without the body. A disembodied ghost.
external	For or concerning students registered with and taking the examinations of a university but not resident there. A department of external affairs.
extrinsic	(of a muscle, such as an eye muscle) having its origin some distance from the part which it moves. Extrinsic evidence.
furnishing	(usually plural) the instrumentalities (furniture and appliances and other movable accessories including curtains and rugs) that make a home (or other area) livable. A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings .
graffiti	Write words or drawings as graffiti. The station was covered in graffiti .
in	A rare soft silvery metallic element occurs in small quantities in sphalerite. The in thing to do.
indoor	Relating to sports played indoors. An indoor pool.
indoors	Into or within a building. They went indoors and explored the house.
inland	Situated in the interior of a country rather than on the coast. The path turned inland and met the road.
inmost	Innermost.
inner	Innermost or essential. The inner cabinet.
innermost	Furthest in; closest to the centre. Innermost beliefs and convictions.
inside	The region that is inside of something. Inside information.
insider	An officer of a corporation or others who have access to private information about the corporation's operations. Political insiders .
interior	An artistic representation of the inside of a building or room. The interior jungle regions.

intramural	Forming part of normal university or college studies. <i>Both intramural and churchyard graves.</i>
inward	Directed or moving inward or toward a center. <i>Inward flood of capital.</i>
inwardly	Within the mind. <i>Inwardly she was raging.</i>
landlocked	Surrounded entirely or almost entirely by land. <i>A landlocked country.</i>
lining	The act of attaching an inside lining to a garment or curtain etc. <i>Self clean oven linings.</i>
located	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Valuable centrally located urban land.</i>
mural	A painting or other work of art executed directly on a wall. <i>Huge murals depicting Norse legends.</i>
outward	Outwards. <i>Move the needle further outward.</i>
position	The relative position or standing of things or especially persons in a society. <i>A development plan which will position the city as a major economic force in the region.</i>
private	Concerning things deeply private and personal. <i>Private property.</i>
program	Write a computer program. <i>You can't tell the players without a program.</i>
redecorate	Apply paint or wallpaper in (a room or building) again, typically differently. <i>You will have to redecorate the room afterwards.</i>
secret	Of information given in confidence or in secret. <i>How did you guess I'd got a secret plan.</i>
therein	(formal) in or into that thing or place. <i>It shall be sufficient evidence of the facts therein contained.</i>
within	Inside; indoors. <i>Beauty coming from within.</i>
