detail	Provide details for. <i>The ambulances were detailed to the fire station.</i>
detailed	Having many details or facts; showing attention to detail. <i>More detailed information was needed.</i>
elaborate	Make more complex, intricate, or richer. <i>Elaborate wrought iron gates.</i>
elaboration	Addition of extra material or illustration or clarifying detail. <i>The speech lacked any elaboration on concrete measures taken.</i>
exactitude	Care and attention to detail. <i>He writes with exactitude and precision.</i>
exegesis	An explanation or critical interpretation (especially of the Bible). <i>The task of biblical exegesis.</i>
intricate	Very complicated or detailed. <i>Intricate lacework.</i>
involution	Reduction in size of an organ or part (as in the return of the uterus to normal size after childbirth). <i>Periods of artistic involution.</i>
<u>labyrinth</u>	A complex structure in the inner ear which contains the organs of hearing and balance It consists of bony cavities the bony labyrinth filled with fluid and lined with sensitive membranes the membranous labyrinth. <i>You lose yourself in a labyrinth of little streets.</i>
<u>labyrinthine</u>	(of a network) like a labyrinth; irregular and twisting. <i>A labyrinthine network of tortuous footpaths.</i>
lapidary	Relating to the engraving, cutting, or polishing of stones and gems. <i>A lapidary statement.</i>
<u>maze</u>	Be dazed and confused. <i>The house has a maze and a walled Italian garden.</i>
minute	The distance covered in a minute by someone driving or walking. <i>It s been a minute since the pop singer has released new music.</i>
<u>minutia</u>	A small or minor detail. <i>He had memorized the many minutiae of the legal code.</i>
navigate	Travel on water propelled by wind or by other means. <i>Whales use their own inbuilt sonar system to navigate.</i>
nicety	A subtle difference in meaning or opinion or attitude. <i>She prided herself on her nicety of pronunciation.</i>
nuance	Give nuances to. <i>The effect of the music is nuanced by the social situation of listeners.</i>

painstakingly	With great care and thoroughness. <i>It is almost a waste of time painstakingly to learn the routines of selling.</i>
pedantic	Marked by a narrow focus on or display of learning especially its trivial aspects. <i>His analyses are careful and even painstaking but never pedantic.</i>
perplexity	A complicated or baffling situation or thing. <i>The dense perplexity of dwarf palm garlanded creepers glossy undergrowth.</i>
precise	Marked by exactness and accuracy of expression or detail. <i>I want as precise a time of death as I can get.</i>
puzzle	A jigsaw puzzle. <i>We puzzled over her sudden departure.</i>
scriptural	Of or pertaining to or contained in or in accordance with the Bible. <i>Scriptural quotations from Genesis.</i>
subtlety	The quality of being difficult to detect or analyze. <i>The textural subtlety of Degas.</i>
technicality	The state of being technical as in the use of technical terms or methods. <i>It is a tribute to the tribunals that the technicality at the heart of the appellate process in these tribunals can and does coexist with the relative informality in atmosphere and with procedural flexibility.</i>
technically	According to the facts or exact meaning of something; strictly. <i>A technically brilliant boxing contest.</i>
