## Associations of "Invaded" (30 Words)

<b>attack</b>	Launch an attack or assault on begin hostilities or start warfare with. <i>An <b>attack</b> of nausea.</i>
<b>breach</b>	An act of breaking or failing to observe a law, agreement, or code of conduct. <i>They alleged <b>breach</b> of copyright.</i>
<a href="#">busybody</a>	A person who meddles in the affairs of others. <i>Others considered him an interfering <b>busybody</b>.</i>
<a href="#">encroach</a>	Advance beyond the usual limit. <i>The sea has <b>encroached</b> all round the coast.</i>
<b>encroachment</b>	Influencing strongly. <i>Urban <b>encroachment</b> of habitat.</i>
<b>impinge</b>	Impinge or infringe upon. <i>Several factors <b>impinge</b> on market efficiency.</i>
<b>incursion</b>	An attack that penetrates into enemy territory. <i><b>Incursions</b> into enemy territory.</i>
<a href="#">infringe</a>	Actively break the terms of (a law, agreement, etc). <i>Such widespread surveillance could <b>infringe</b> personal liberties.</i>
<b>interfere</b>	Of light or other electromagnetic waveforms interact to produce interference. <i>Light pulses <b>interfere</b> constructively in a fibre to emit a pulse.</i>
<b>interfering</b>	(of a person) tending to interfere in other people’s affairs. <i><b>Interfering</b> busybodies.</i>
<a href="#">interloper</a>	Someone who intrudes on the privacy or property of another without permission. <i>To her I was always an outsider an <b>interloper</b>.</i>
<a href="#">intervene</a>	Occur between other event or between certain points of time. <i>He acted outside his authority when he <b>intervened</b> in the dispute.</i>

<b><u>intrude</u></b>	Enter unlawfully on someone's property. <i>To <b>intrude</b> political criteria into military decisions risks reducing efficiency.</i>
<b><u>intruder</u></b>	A person who intrudes, especially into a building with criminal intent. <i>The <b>intruder</b> had pulled out drawers and dumped their contents on the floor.</i>
<b><u>intrusion</u></b>	The action of intruding. <i>He was furious about this <b>intrusion</b> into his private life.</i>
<b><u>intrusive</u></b>	(of a sound) pronounced between words or syllables to facilitate pronunciation, such as an r in saw a film. <i>Tourist attractions that are environmentally <b>intrusive</b>.</i>
<b>invasion</b>	The act of invading; the act of an army that invades for conquest or plunder. <i>The tumor s <b>invasion</b> of surrounding structures.</i>
<b>meddling</b>	Intrusive in a meddling or offensive manner. <i>My mother s <b>meddlings</b> annoyed me.</i>
<b>misdemeanor</b>	A crime less serious than a felony.
<b><u>oppressor</u></b>	A person of authority who subjects others to undue pressures. <i>They overthrew their colonial <b>oppressors</b>.</i>
<b><u>raid</u></b>	Conduct a raid on. <i>Officers <b>raided</b> thirty homes yesterday.</i>
<b><u>robber</u></b>	A person who commits robbery.
<b><u>transgress</u></b>	Act in disregard of laws, rules, contracts, or promises. <i>She had <b>transgressed</b> an unwritten social law.</i>
<b>trespass</b>	Enter someone's land or property without permission. <i>Don t <b>trespass</b> on my land.</i>
<b>trespasser</b>	A person entering someone's land or property without permission. <i>A <b>trespasser</b> on his land.</i>
<b>usurpation</b>	Entry to another's property without right or permission. <i>A succession of generals who ruled by <b>usurpation</b>.</i>
<b>violate</b>	Violate the sacred character of a place or language. <i>They <b>violated</b> the terms of a ceasefire.</i>
<b><u>violation</u></b>	A disrespectful act. <i>Flagrant <b>violations</b> of normal democratic procedure.</i>
<b>violator</b>	A person who breaks or fails to comply with a rule or formal agreement. <i>Monica is able to name the <b>violators</b> of her body.</i>
