Associations of "Invading" (30 Words)

attack	The act of attacking. <i>Attacks on women increased last year.</i>
breach	An opening (especially a gap in a dike or fortification. A breach of confidence.
<u>busybody</u>	A person who meddles in the affairs of others. Others considered him an interfering busybody .
<u>encroach</u>	Impinge or infringe upon. Rather than encroach on his privacy she might have kept to her room.
encroachment	Entry to another's property without right or permission. Urban encroachment of habitat.
impinge	Impinge or infringe upon. The gases impinge on the surface of the liquid.



incursion	An invasion or attack, especially a sudden or brief one. <i>Incursion</i> s into enemy territory.
<u>infringe</u>	Actively break the terms of (a law, agreement, etc. <i>Making an unauthorized copy would infringe copyright.</i>
interfere	Of light or other electromagnetic waveforms interact to produce interference. A holiday job would interfere with his studies.
interfering	Intrusive in a meddling or offensive manner. An interfering old woman.
<u>interloper</u>	A person who becomes involved in a place or situation where they are not wanted or are considered not to belong. <i>To her I was always an outsider an interloper.</i>
<u>intervene</u>	Get involved, so as to alter or hinder an action, or through force or threat of force. <i>He acted outside his authority when he</i> intervene <i>d in the dispute.</i>
<u>intrude</u>	Enter unlawfully on someone's property. The granite may have intrude d these rock layers.
<u>intruder</u>	A person who intrudes, especially into a building with criminal intent. The intruder had pulled out drawers and dumped their contents on the floor.
<u>intrusion</u>	The forcing of molten rock into fissures or between strata of an earlier rock formation. <i>Villagers say the noise is an intrusion on their lives.</i>
<u>intrusive</u>	Tending to intrude (especially upon privacy. That was an intrusive question.
invasion	An instance of invading a country or region with an armed force. In 1546 England had to be defended from invasion .
meddling	Intrusive in a meddling or offensive manner. <i>Bureaucratic meddling.</i>
misdemeanor	A crime less serious than a felony.
<u>oppressor</u>	A person or group that oppresses people. They overthrew their colonial oppressor s.
<u>raid</u>	Conduct a raid on. A police raid on his home.
<u>robber</u>	A person who commits robbery.
<u>transgress</u>	Spread over land, especially along a subsiding shoreline. The sea transgress es along the West coast of the island.



trespass	Enter unlawfully on someone's property. Don t trespass on my land.
trespasser	Someone who intrudes on the privacy or property of another without permission. <i>A trespasser</i> on his land.
usurpation	Entry to another's property without right or permission. A succession of generals who ruled by usurpation .
violate	Violate the sacred character of a place or language. They violate d the terms of a ceasefire.
<u>violation</u>	The action of violating someone or something. The aircraft were in violation of UN resolutions.
violator	Someone who violates the law. Monica is able to name the violator s of her body.
<u>visitor</u>	A member of a sports team on tour or playing away from home. The visitor s came back into the game with two penalty goals.
