# **Conjugate Invect**

### **Invect in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I invect	We <b>invect</b>
You <b>invect</b>	You <b>invect</b>
He/She/It invects	They <b>invect</b>

### **Invect in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am invecting	We are invecting
You <b>are invecting</b>	You <b>are invecting</b>
He/She/It is invecting	They <b>are invecting</b>

#### **Invect in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have invected	We have invected
You have invected	You have invected
He/She/It has invected They have invected	

### **Invect in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been invecting	We have been invecting
You <b>have been invecting</b>	You have been invecting
He/She/It has been invecting They have been invecting	

## **Invect in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I invected	We <b>invected</b>
You <b>invected</b>	You <b>invected</b>
He/She/It invected	They <b>invected</b>

### **Invect in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was invecting	We <b>were invecting</b>
You were invecting	You were invecting
He/She/It was invecting	They were invecting

#### **Invect in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had invected	We had invected
You had invected	You <b>had invected</b>
He/She/It had invected They had invected	

### **Invect in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been invecting	We had been invecting
You <b>had been invecting</b>	You had been invecting
He/She/It had been invecting	They had been invecting

### **Invect in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will invect	We will invect
You <b>will invect</b>	You <b>will invect</b>
He/She/It will invect	They will invect

### **Invect in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

SingularPluralI will be invectingWe will be invectingYou will be invectingYou will be invectingHe/She/It will be invectingThey will be invecting

#### **Invect in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have invected	We will have invected
You <b>will have invected</b>	You will have invected
He/She/It will have invected	They will have invected

## **Invect in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been invecting	We <b>will have been invecting</b>
You <b>will have been invecting</b>	You will have been invecting
He/She/It will have been invecting They will have been invecting
