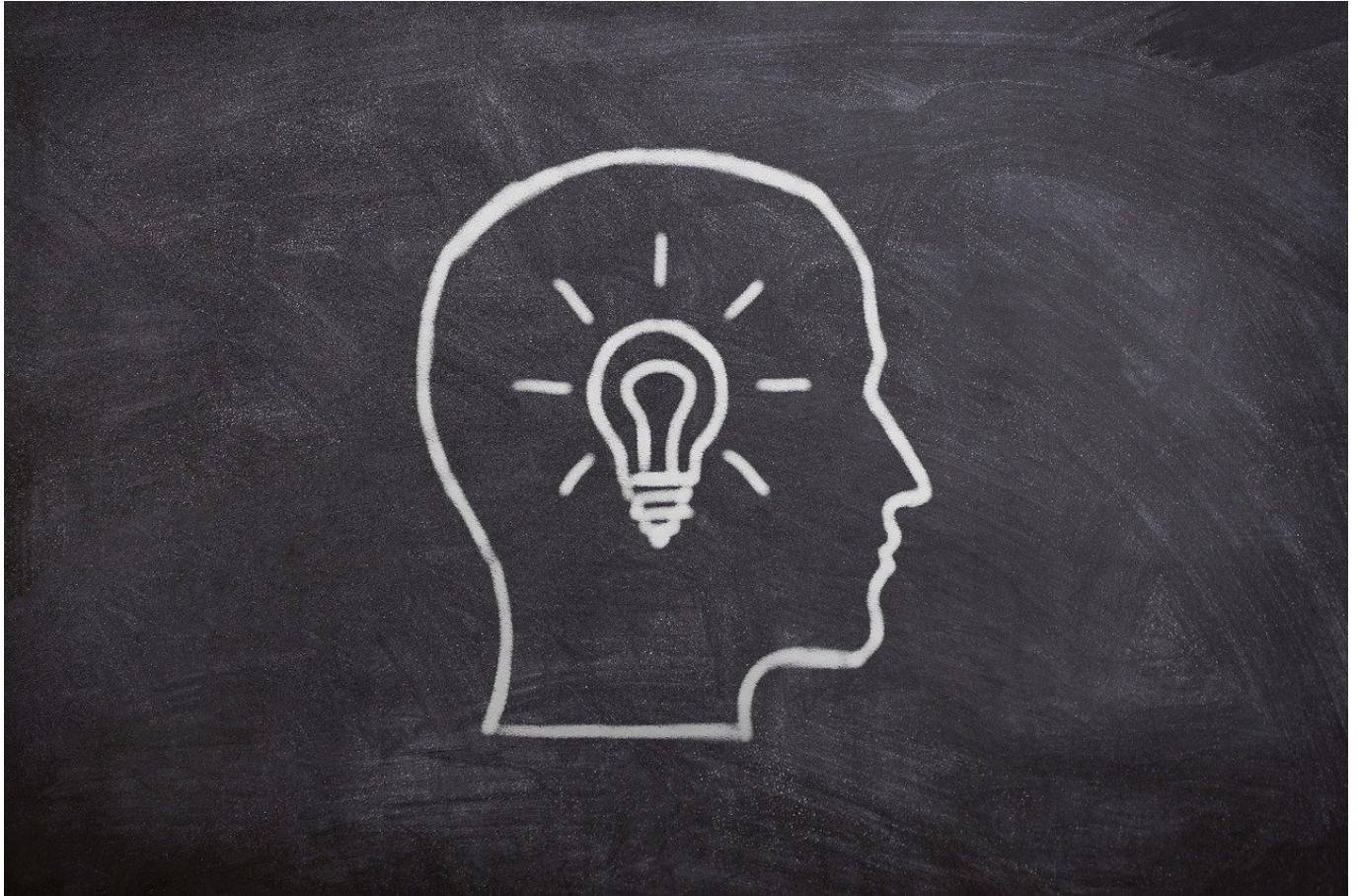

## Associations of "Inventions" (30 Words)

### abstraction

The act of withdrawing or removing something.  
*She sensed his momentary **abstraction**.*

### artwork

Illustrations, photographs, or other non-textual material prepared for inclusion in a publication.  
*A collection of **artwork** from tribal cultures.*

### conceive

Judge or regard; look upon; judge.  
*The dam project was originally **conceived** in 1977.*

### conception

Ability to imagine; understanding.  
*Our **conception** of how language relates to reality.*

### contrive

Come up with (an idea, plan, explanation, theory, or principle) after a mental effort.  
*They **contrived** to murder their boss.*

<b>creation</b>	God's act of bringing the universe into existence. <i><b>Creation</b> of a coalition government.</i>
<b>creative</b>	A person whose job involves creative work. <i>The most important people in the mix will be <b>creatives</b> and direct marketing specialists.</i>
<b>creatively</b>	In a creative manner. <i>This article inspires you to think <b>creatively</b>.</i>
<b>creativeness</b>	The ability to create.
<b>creativity</b>	The ability to create. <i>Firms are keen to encourage <b>creativity</b>.</i>
<u><b>devise</b></u>	Plan or invent (a complex procedure, system, or mechanism) by careful thought. <i><b>Devise</b> a plan to take over the director s office.</i>
<u><b>discovery</b></u>	The act of discovering something. <i>The drug is not a new <b>discovery</b>.</i>
<b>feign</b>	Make a pretence of. <i>He <b>feigned</b> that he was ill.</i>
<b>figment</b>	A contrived or fantastic idea. <i>It really was Ross and not a <b>figment</b> of her overheated imagination.</i>
<b>freshness</b>	The quality of being pleasantly new or different. <i>The restaurant s selling point is the <b>freshness</b> of its ingredients.</i>
<u><b>groundbreaking</b></u>	Innovative; pioneering. <i><b>Groundbreaking</b> research into fertility problems.</i>
<b>hallucinatory</b>	Of or resembling a hallucination. <i>A <b>hallucinatory</b> fantasy.</i>
<b>idea</b>	The aim or purpose. <i>It s a good <b>idea</b> to do some research before you go.</i>
<u><b>imagination</b></u>	The ability to deal resourcefully with unusual problems. <i><b>Imagination</b> reveals what the world could be.</i>
<u><b>imaginative</b></u>	Having or showing creativity or inventiveness. <i>He was <b>imaginative</b> beyond all other architects.</i>
<b>ingenious</b>	Showing inventiveness and skill. <i>An <b>ingenious</b> solution to the problem.</i>
<b>ingenuity</b>	The property of being ingenious. <i>Considerable <b>ingenuity</b> must be employed in writing software.</i>

<b>innovation</b>	The creation of something in the mind. <i>Technological <b>innovations</b> designed to save energy.</i>
<b>innovative</b>	Being or producing something like nothing done or experienced or created before. <i><b>Innovative</b> ways to help unemployed people.</i>
<b><u>inventive</u></b>	Showing creativity or original thought. <i>A courageous and <b>inventive</b> piece of film making.</i>
<b>make</b>	Compel or make somebody or something to act in a certain way. <i>He waited confidently for his band to <b>make</b> it.</i>
<b>new</b>	Beginning anew and in a transformed way. <i>The <b>new</b> Madonna album.</i>
<b><u>novelty</u></b>	The quality of being new, original, or unusual. <i>A <b>novelty</b> teapot.</i>
<b><u>originality</u></b>	The quality of being new and original (not derived from something else). <i>She s a writer of great <b>originality</b>.</i>
