avant-garde	Radically new or original.
creative	Having good imagination or original ideas. <i>Creative</i> work.
<u>experimental</u>	(of art or an artistic technique) involving a radically new and innovative style. An <b>experimental</b> knowledge of God.
<u>fertile</u>	(of nuclear material) able to become fissile by the capture of neutrons. <i>The <b>fertile</b> coastal plain.</i>
fresh	Pleasantly clean and cool. A <b>fresh</b> start.



<u>imaginative</u>	(used of persons or artifacts) marked by independence and creativity in thought or action. <i>He was <b>imaginative</b></i> beyond all other architects.
ingenious	(of a machine or idea) cleverly and originally devised and well suited to its purpose. <i>He was <b>ingenious</b> enough to overcome the limited budget.</i>
innovational	Being or producing something like nothing done or experienced or created before. A mind so <b>innovational</b> so original.
innovative	Being or producing something like nothing done or experienced or created before. Innovative members of the artistic community.
new	Beginning anew and in a transformed way. A way of living that was <b>new</b> to me.
<u>novel</u>	Original and of a kind not seen before. The computer produced a completely <b>novel</b> proof of a well known theorem.
<u>original</u>	(of e.g. information) not secondhand or by way of something intermediary. <i>The book still has its <b>original</b> binding.</i>
<u>resourceful</u>	Having inner resources; adroit or imaginative. <i>He maintained her reputation for being a <b>resourceful</b> problem solver.</i>
unconventional	Not conforming to accepted rules or standards. An <b>unconventional</b> marriage.
<u>unfamiliar</u>	Unusual or uncharacteristic. His voice was <b>unfamiliar</b> to her.
unorthodox	Contrary to what is usual, traditional, or accepted; not orthodox. An <b>unorthodox</b> lifestyle.
unprecedented	Having no precedent; novel. The government took the <b>unprecedented</b> step of releasing confidential correspondence.
unusual	Not commonly encountered. It was <b>unusual</b> for Dennis to be late.


