Past Tense	<b>inversed</b>
Present Participle	<b>inversing</b>
Past Participle	<b>inversed</b>

### Inverse in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **inverse**

We **inverse**

You **inverse**

You **inverse**

He/She/It **inverses** They **inverse**

## **Inverse in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am inversing**

We **are inversing**

You **are inversing**

You **are inversing**

He/She/It **is inversing** They **are inversing**

## **Inverse in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have inversed**

We **have inversed**

You **have inversed**

You **have inversed**

He/She/It **has inversed** They **have inversed**

## **Inverse in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been inversing**

We **have been inversing**

You **have been inversing**

You **have been inversing**

He/She/It **has been inversing** They **have been inversing**

## **Inverse in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **inversed**

We **inversed**

You **inversed**

You **inversed**

He/She/It **inversed** They **inversed**

## **Inverse in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was <b>inversing</b>	We were <b>inversing</b>
You were <b>inversing</b>	You were <b>inversing</b>
He/She/It was <b>inversing</b>	They were <b>inversing</b>

**Inverse in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had <b>inversed</b>	We had <b>inversed</b>
You had <b>inversed</b>	You had <b>inversed</b>
He/She/It had <b>inversed</b>	They had <b>inversed</b>

**Inverse in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been <b>inversing</b>	We had been <b>inversing</b>
You had been <b>inversing</b>	You had been <b>inversing</b>
He/She/It had been <b>inversing</b>	They had been <b>inversing</b>

**Inverse in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I will <b>inverse</b>	We will <b>inverse</b>
You will <b>inverse</b>	You will <b>inverse</b>
He/She/It will <b>inverse</b>	They will <b>inverse</b>

**Inverse in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I will be <b>inversing</b>	We will be <b>inversing</b>
You will be <b>inversing</b>	You will be <b>inversing</b>
He/She/It will be <b>inversing</b>	They will be <b>inversing</b>

**Inverse in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have inverted**

**We will have inverted**

**You will have inverted**

**You will have inverted**

**He/She/It will have inverted**

**They will have inverted**

**Inverse in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**I will have been inversing**

**We will have been inversing**

**You will have been inversing**

**You will have been inversing**

**He/She/It will have been inversing**

**They will have been inversing**
