<u>afford</u>	Afford access to. Our meeting <b>afford</b> ed much interesting information.
<u>amortize</u>	Reduce or pay off (a debt) with regular payments. Lands <b>amortize</b> d without licence.
authorize	Give or delegate power or authority to. She <b>authorize</b> d her assistant to sign the papers.
bonus	An additional payment (or other remuneration) to employees as a means of increasing output. Good weather is an added <b>bonus</b> but the real appeal is the landscape.
<u>capitalize</u>	Draw advantages from. <i>People should have the right to <b>capitalize</b> part of the value of these benefits.</i>
company	Accompany someone. She is excellent <b>company</b> .
deductible	The part of an insurance claim to be paid by the insured; an excess. <i>Childcare vouchers will be <b>deductible</b> expenses for employers.</i>
dividend	An individual s share of a dividend. Buying a rail pass may still pay <b>dividend</b> s.
<u>empower</u>	Give or delegate power or authority to. Movements to <b>empower</b> the poor.
enable	Make (something) possible. The Department is leading the effort to <b>enable</b> a smooth and timely transition.
endue	Give qualities or abilities to. Our sight would be <b>endue</b> d with a far greater sharpness.
enthrone	Put a monarch on the throne. He was <b>enthrone</b> d as the guru of the avant garde.



exemption	Immunity from an obligation or duty. Vehicles that may qualify for <b>exemption</b> from tax.
finance	The management of money and credit and banking and investments. Can we <b>finance</b> the addition to our home.
<u>give</u>	Yield or give way to pressure. What <b>give</b> s.
grant	A right or privilege that has been granted. He hasn t made much progress I ll <b>grant</b> you that.
harpoon	Spear with a harpoon. <i>Harpoon</i> whales.
impale	Kill by piercing with a spear or sharp pole. The enemies were <b>impale</b> d and left to die.
<u>income</u>	The financial gain (earned or unearned) accruing over a given period of time. <i>Figures showed an overall increase in income this year.</i>
induct	Introduce or initiate. There was a ceremony to <b>induct</b> the president of the Academy.
installment	A payment of part of a debt; usually paid at regular intervals.
mortgage	The amount of money borrowed in a mortgage. Some people worry that selling off state assets <b>mortgage</b> s the country s future.
payment	A sum of money paid or a claim discharged. A compensation <b>payment</b> of 2500.
porcupine	Relatively large rodents with sharp erectile bristles mingled with the fur.
shareholder	An owner of shares in a company.
<u>spike</u>	Secure with spikes. <i>Spike</i> the liquid with lime or lemon juice.
<u>stake</u>	Mark with a stake. Bishop Ridley was burned at the <b>stake</b> .
stick	Stick to firmly. Janet s not such a bad old <b>stick</b> sometimes.
sticker	A particularly difficult or baffling question or problem. A disabled <b>sticker</b> for our car.
<u>thorn</u>	A thorny bush shrub or tree especially a hawthorn. <i>He s a <b>thorn</b> in my flesh.</i>
