Investigate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **investigate** We **investigate** You **investigate** You **investigate** He/She/It **investigates** They **investigate**

Investigate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am investigating We are investigating You are investigating He/She/It is investigating They are investigating

Investigate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have investigated We have investigated You have investigated He/She/It has investigated They have investigated

Investigate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been investigating
You have been investigating
He/She/It has been investigating
They have been investigating

Investigate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **investigated** We **investigated**You **investigated** You **investigated**He/She/It **investigated** They **investigated**

Investigate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was investigating We were investigating
You were investigating You were investigating
He/She/It was investigating They were investigating

Investigate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had investigated We had investigated You had investigated He/She/It had investigated They had investigated

Investigate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been investigating
You had been investigating
He/She/It had been investigating
They had been investigating

Investigate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will investigate
You will investigate
He/She/It will investigate
They will investigate

Investigate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be investigating
You will be investigating
He/She/It will be investigating
They will be investigating

Investigate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have investigated We will have investigated You will have investigated He/She/It will have investigated They will have investigated

Investigate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been investigating
You will have been investigating
He/She/It will have been investigating
They will have been investigating
