animating	Giving spirit and vivacity.
<u>blissful</u>	Providing perfect happiness or great joy. <i>Blissful young lovers.</i>
bracing	Imparting vitality and energy. <i>The bracing sea air.</i>
challenging	Testing one’s abilities; demanding. <i>Performed the most challenging task without a mistake.</i>
<u>corrective</u>	Designed to correct or counteract something harmful or undesirable. <i>Corrective measures.</i>
<u>enliven</u>	Make lively. <i>The visit had clearly enlivened my mother.</i>
<u>entertaining</u>	Agreeably diverting. <i>Films should be entertaining.</i>
exciting	Causing great enthusiasm and eagerness. <i>An exciting account of her trip.</i>
<u>exhilarating</u>	Making lively and joyful. <i>The exhilarating effect of mountain air.</i>
fresh	(of a cycle) beginning or occurring again. <i>The foliage was still a fresh colour.</i>
healthful	Having or conducive to good health. <i>Healthful nutrition.</i>
inspire	Create (a feeling, especially a positive one) in a person. <i>They can expand their lungs and inspire enough gas to satisfy oxygen requirements.</i>
<u>inspiring</u>	Having the effect of inspiring someone. <i>He was an inspiring teacher.</i>

motivation	A reason or reasons for acting or behaving in a particular way. <i>The following proposal and motivation is submitted for consideration.</i>
novelty	A small and inexpensive toy or ornament. <i>In 1914 air travel was still a novelty.</i>
piquant	Pleasantly stimulating or exciting to the mind. <i>A piquant face with large appealing eyes.</i>
pop	Like a pop or with a pop. <i>The farm popped into view as we turned the corner.</i>
raunchy	Shabby or grubby. <i>The restaurant's style is raunchy and the sanitation chancy.</i>
recent	New. <i>His recent visit to Britain.</i>
recuperative	Having the effect of restoring health or strength. <i>Recuperative powers.</i>
refreshing	Serving to refresh or reinvigorate someone. <i>It makes a refreshing change to be able to write about something nice.</i>
restorative	Promoting recuperation. <i>Restorative effects of exercise.</i>
rousing	Capable of arousing enthusiasm or excitement. <i>A rousing speech.</i>
sensational	Causing great public interest and excitement. <i>You look sensational.</i>
stimulant	A drug that temporarily quickens some vital process. <i>Caffeine has stimulant effects on the heart.</i>
stimulating	That stimulates. <i>A stimulating discussion.</i>
stirring	An initial sign of activity, movement, or emotion. <i>A stirring and thriving politician.</i>
straightforwardness	The quality of being direct and straightforward. <i>What some people take for rudeness is really straightforwardness.</i>
thrilling	Causing excitement and pleasure; exhilarating. <i>A thrilling wind blew off the frozen lake.</i>
tonic	Music the first note of a diatonic scale. <i>A tonic body shampoo.</i>
