<b>abiding</b>	(of a feeling or memory) lasting a long time; enduring. <i>He had an <b>abiding</b> respect for her.</i>
<b>always</b>	At all times; on all occasions. <i>I will <b>always</b> be there to help you.</i>
<b><u>ceaseless</u></b>	Constant and unending. <i>The fort was subjected to <b>ceaseless</b> bombardment.</i>
<b>changeless</b>	Remaining the same. <i><b>Changeless</b> truths.</i>
<b>committed</b>	Bound or obligated, as under a pledge to a particular cause, action, or attitude. <i>A <b>committed</b> Marxist.</i>
<b>confirmed</b>	Having been established or made firm or received the rite of confirmation. <i>Received <b>confirmed</b> reports of casualties.</i>
<b>constant</b>	A situation that does not change. <i><b>Constant</b> as the northern star.</i>
<b><u>continually</u></b>	Repeated frequently in the same way; regularly. <i>This information is <b>continually</b> updated.</i>
<b>continuously</b>	Without interruption or gaps. <i>These images loop <b>continuously</b>.</i>
<b>endless</b>	(of a belt, chain, or tape) having the ends joined to form a loop allowing continuous action. <i><b>Endless</b> waves.</i>
<b><u>enduring</u></b>	Lasting over a period of time; durable. <i>He formed a number of <b>enduring</b> relationships with women.</i>
<b><u>eternal</u></b>	Lasting or existing forever; without end. <i><b>Eternal</b> nagging demands.</i>

<b>eternity</b>	A state to which time has no application; timelessness. <i>Immortal souls destined for <b>eternity</b>.</i>
<b>ever</b>	At all times all the time and on every occasion. <i>Why <b>ever</b> did you do it.</i>
<b>every</b>	(used of count nouns) each and all of the members of a group considered singly and without exception. <i><b>Every</b> chance of winning.</i>
<b>forever</b>	For a limitless time- P.P.Bliss. <i>It took <b>forever</b> to get a passport.</i>
<b>immutable</b>	Unchanging over time or unable to be changed. <i>An <b>immutable</b> fact.</i>
<b>incessant</b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>Night and day we live with the <b>incessant</b> noise of the city.</i>
<b>incessantly</b>	With unflagging resolve. <i>She talked about him <b>incessantly</b>.</i>
<b>invariably</b>	In every case or on every occasion; always. <i>Ranch meals are <b>invariably</b> big and hearty.</i>
<b>permanence</b>	The state or quality of lasting or remaining unchanged indefinitely. <i>The clarity and <b>permanence</b> of the dyes.</i>
<b>permanency</b>	The property of being able to exist for an indefinite duration.
<b>perpetual</b>	Never ending or changing. <i>A <b>perpetual</b> secretary of the society.</i>
<b>perpetually</b>	In a way that never ends or changes; constantly. <i><b>Perpetually</b> hungry teenage boys.</i>
<b>persistent</b>	Never-ceasing. <i>An attempt to stop <b>persistent</b> drink drivers.</i>
<b>steady</b>	Make or become steady. <i>She tried to keep her voice <b>steady</b>.</i>
<b>unceasing</b>	Continuing forever or indefinitely. <i>Man s <b>unceasing</b> warfare with drought and isolation.</i>
<b>unchangeable</b>	Not changeable or subject to change. <i>The <b>unchangeable</b> seasons.</i>
<b>unlimited</b>	That cannot be entirely consumed or used up. <i>To start with a theory of <b>unlimited</b> freedom is to end up with <b>unlimited</b> despotism.</i>
<b>utter</b>	Express audibly utter sounds not necessarily words. <i><b>Utter</b> seriousness.</i>
