Associations of "Irrigation" (30 Words)

aqueduct	A conduit that resembles a bridge but carries water over a valley.
basin	The quantity that a basin will hold. <i>The Amazon basin.</i>
canal	Provide a city with a canal. <i>They travelled on by canal.</i>
canalize	Convert (a river) into a navigable canal. <i>Successive railway engineers were to divert and canalize many miles of river.</i>
channel	A service or station using a channel of frequencies. <i>She was channelling the spirit of Billie Holiday.</i>
coast	A slope down which sleds may coast. <i>The west coast of Africa.</i>
conduit	A passage (a pipe or tunnel) through which water or electric wires can pass. <i>The gas pipe should not be close to any electrical conduit.</i>
ditch	Provide with a ditch or ditches. <i>Ditch the land to drain it.</i>
drain	Empty of liquid drain the liquid from. <i>The land was drained and the boggy ground reclaimed.</i>
drainage	A system of drains. <i>They set about renewing and repairing drainage and water supplies.</i>
exhaust	The system through which exhaust gases are expelled. <i>This kind of work exhausts me.</i>
flow	The amount of fluid that flows in a given time. <i>Under the ford the river backs up giving a deep sluggish flow.</i>
fluvial	Of or found in a river. <i>Fluvial deposits.</i>

incised	Cut or impressed into a surface. <i>An incised design.</i>
irrigate	Supply water to (land or crops) to help growth, typically by means of channels. <i>Irrigate the wound.</i>
isthmus	A narrow strip of land with sea on either side, forming a link between two larger areas of land.
lake	A body of (usually fresh) water surrounded by land. <i>The EU wine lake.</i>
metamorphic	Of or marked by metamorphosis. <i>Marble is a metamorphic rock that takes a high polish.</i>
moat	Surround a place with a moat.
navigable	(of a waterway or sea) able to be sailed on by ships or boats. <i>Navigable waters.</i>
pipe	Play a tune on a pipe or pipes. <i>Pipe a tune.</i>
pipeline	Convey a substance by a pipeline. <i>Chip designers pipeline the instructions given to the hardware.</i>
river	A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea a lake or another river. <i>The river was navigable for 50 miles.</i>
sedimentary	(of rock) that has formed from sediment deposited by water or air.
strait	A bad or difficult situation or state of affairs. <i>My captivity was strait as ever.</i>
surfing	The sport or pastime of riding a wave towards the shore while standing or lying on a surfboard. <i>Why share your internet connection with people surfing and chatting.</i>
trench	A trench coat. <i>The slaughter in the trenches created a new cynicism.</i>
vacate	Leave (a job, post, or position) voluntarily. <i>You must vacate your office by tonight.</i>
waterway	A channel at the outer edge of a deck of a boat that allows water to run off. <i>The canal was a very successful commercial waterway.</i>
