Past Tense	island-hopped
Present Participle	island-hopping

# **Conjugate Island-hop**

#### Island-hop in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>island-hop</b>	We <b>island-hop</b>
You <b>island-hop</b>	You <b>island-hop</b>
He/She/It island-hops	They island-hop

#### Island-hop in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am island-hopping	We are island-hopping
You <b>are island-hopping</b>	You <b>are island-hopping</b>
He/She/It is island-hopping	They are island-hopping

#### **Island-hop in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have island-hopped	We have island-hopped
You have island-hopped	You have island-hopped
He/She/It has island-hopped	They have island-hopped

## **Island-hop in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been island-hopping	We have been island-hopping
You <b>have been island-hopping</b>	You have been island-hopping
He/She/It has been island-hopping	They have been island-hopping

## Island-hop in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I island-hopped	We <b>island-hopped</b>
You <b>island-hopped</b>	You <b>island-hopped</b>
He/She/It island-hopped	They island-hopped

#### Island-hop in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was island-hopping	We were island-hopping
You <b>were island-hopping</b>	You were island-hopping
He/She/It was island-hopping	They were island-hopping

#### **Island-hop in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had island-hopped	We had island-hopped
You <b>had island-hopped</b>	You had island-hopped
He/She/It had island-hopped	They had island-hopped

#### **Island-hop in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been island-hopping	We had been island-hopping
You <b>had been island-hopping</b>	You had been island-hopping
He/She/It had been island-hopping	They had been island-hopping

## Island-hop in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will island-hop	We will island-hop
You <b>will island-hop</b>	You <b>will island-hop</b>
He/She/It will island-hop	They will island-hop

## Island-hop in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be island-hopping	We <b>will be island-hopping</b>
You <b>will be island-hopping</b>	You <b>will be island-hopping</b>
He/She/It will be island-hopping	They will be island-hopping

#### **Island-hop in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have island-hopped	We will have island-hopped
You <b>will have island-hopped</b>	You will have island-hopped
He/She/It will have island-hopped	They will have island-hopped

## Island-hop in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been island-hopping	We will have been island-hopping
You <b>will have been island-hopping</b>	You <b>will have been island-hopping</b>
He/She/It will have been island-hopping	They will have been island-hopping
