### Definitions of "Iteration" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “iteration” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A new version of a piece of computer hardware or software.*
- *Executing the same set of instructions a given number of times or until a specified result is obtained.*
- *(computer science) executing the same set of instructions a given number of times or until a specified result is obtained.*
- *(computer science) a single execution of a set of instructions that are to be repeated.*
- *The repetition of a process or utterance.*
- *Doing or saying again; a repeated performance.*
- *Repetition of a mathematical or computational procedure applied to the result of a previous application, typically as a means of obtaining successively closer approximations to the solution of a problem.*
- *A single execution of a set of instructions that are to be repeated.*



## Synonyms of "Iteration" as a noun (10 Words)

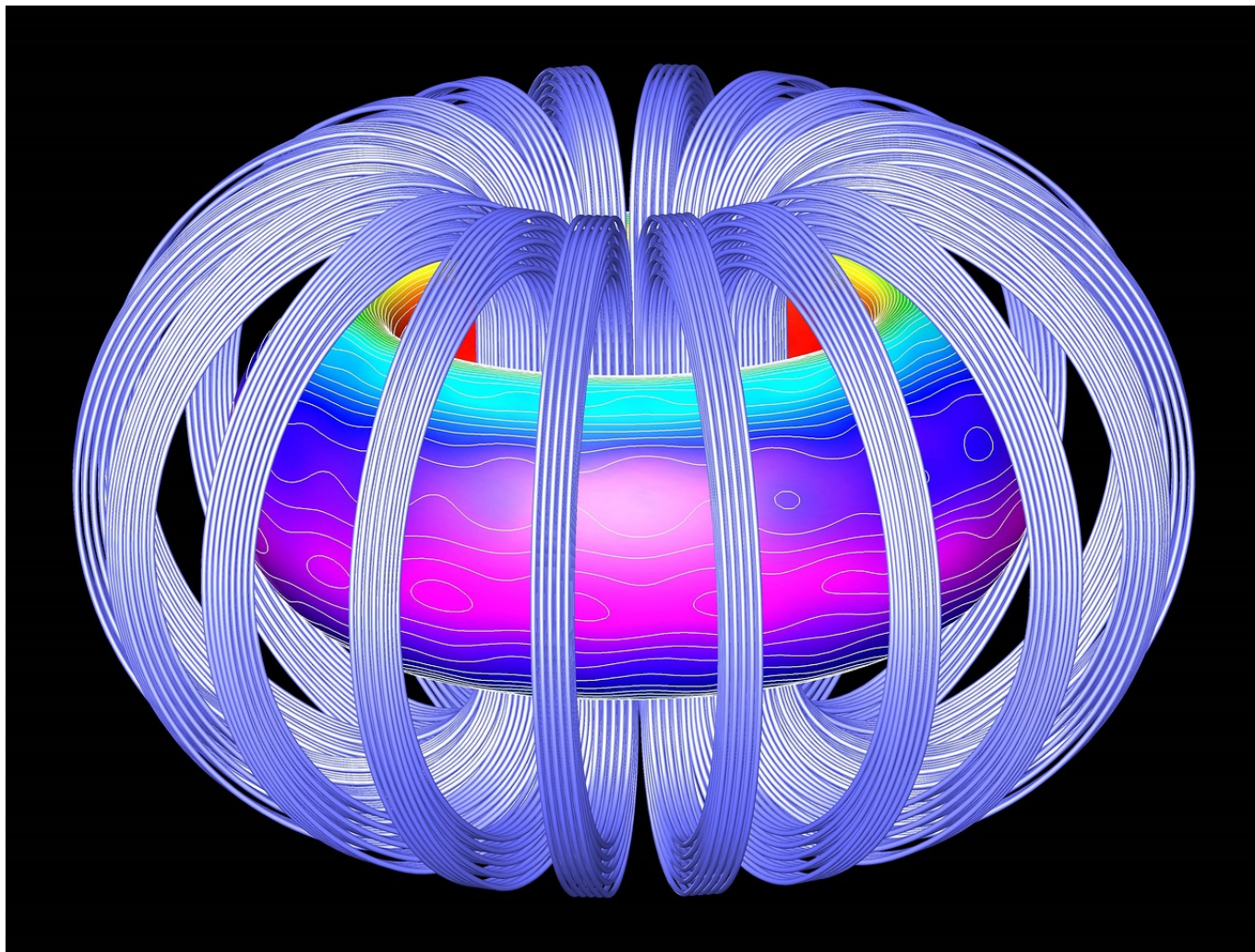
<b>duplication</b>	A DNA segment in a chromosome which is a copy of another segment. <i>This kind of <b>duplication</b> is wasteful.</i>
<b>loop</b>	An intrauterine device in the shape of a loop. <i>Make a <b>loop</b> in the twine.</i>
<b>looping</b>	The basic pattern of the human fingerprint.
<b>periphrasis</b>	The use of indirect and circumlocutory speech or writing. <i>A rather pompous <b>periphrasis</b>.</i>
<b>redundancy</b>	The attribute of being superfluous and unneeded. <i>The use of industrial robots created <b>redundancy</b> among workers.</i>
<b>reiteration</b>	The action of repeating something, typically for emphasis or clarity. <i>The <b>reiteration</b> of his campaign promise to cut taxes.</i>
<b>repetition</b>	The action of repeating something that has already been said or written. <i>The geometric <b>repetitions</b> of Islamic art.</i>



**repetitiousness** Verboseness resulting from excessive repetitions.

**repetitiveness** Verboseness resulting from excessive repetitions.

**superfluity** Extreme excess.  
*Servants who had nothing to do but to display their own **superfluity**.*
