
Iteration as a Noun

Definitions of "Iteration" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "iteration" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A new version of a piece of computer hardware or software.
- Executing the same set of instructions a given number of times or until a specified result is obtained.
- (computer science) executing the same set of instructions a given number of times or until a specified result is obtained.
- (computer science) a single execution of a set of instructions that are to be repeated.
- The repetition of a process or utterance.
- Doing or saying again; a repeated performance.
- Repetition of a mathematical or computational procedure applied to the result of a previous application, typically as a means of obtaining successively closer approximations to the solution of a problem.
- A single execution of a set of instructions that are to be repeated.

The geometric **repetition**s of Islamic art.




repetitiousness Verboseness resulting from excessive repetitions.
