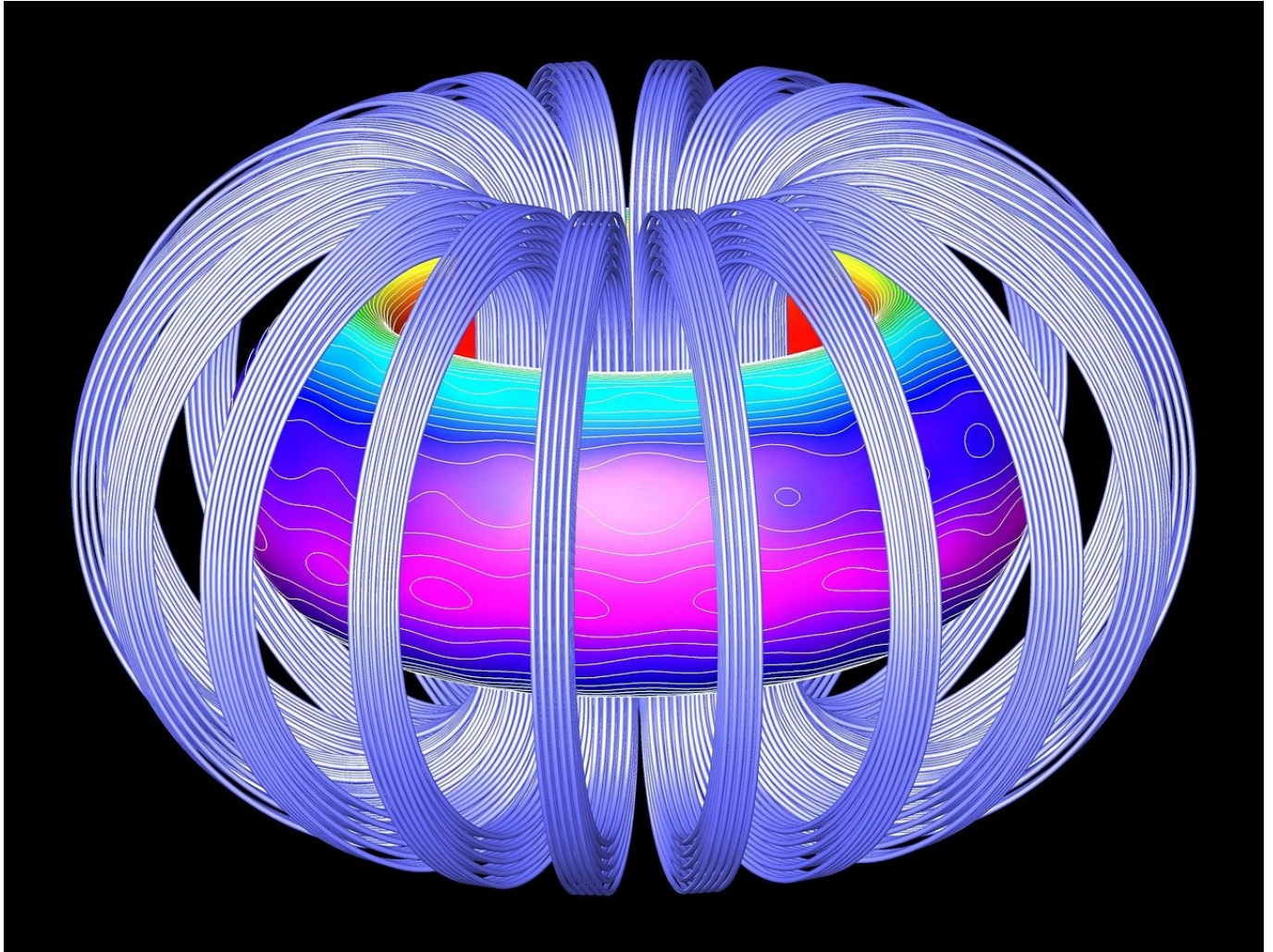

- *Marked by iteration.*
- *Denoting a grammatical rule that can be applied repeatedly.*

constant	(of a person) unchangingly faithful and dependable. <i>A man constant in adherence to his ideals.</i>
incessant	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>The incessant beat of the music.</i>
reiterative	Marked by iteration.
repeated	Recurring again and again. <i>There were repeated attempts to negotiate.</i>
<u>repetitive</u>	Repetitive and persistent. <i>Repetitive movement.</i>
<u>unremitting</u>	Never relaxing or slackening; incessant. <i>Unremitting drizzle.</i>
