Infinitive	<b>to jobe</b>
Present Tense	<b>jobe / jobs</b>
Past Tense	<b>jobed</b>
Present Participle	<b>jobing</b>
Past Participle	<b>jobed</b>

## Conjugate Jobe

**Jobe in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>jobe</b>	We <b>jobe</b>
You <b>jobe</b>	You <b>jobe</b>
He/She/It <b>jobes</b>	They <b>jobe</b>

## **Jobe in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am jobing</b>	We <b>are jobing</b>
You <b>are jobing</b>	You <b>are jobing</b>
He/She/It <b>is jobing</b>	They <b>are jobing</b>

I <b>have jobed</b>	We <b>have jobed</b>
You <b>have jobed</b>	You <b>have jobed</b>
He/She/It <b>has jobed</b>	They <b>have jobed</b>

I <b>have been jobing</b>	We <b>have been jobing</b>
You <b>have been jobing</b>	You <b>have been jobing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been jobing</b>	They <b>have been jobing</b>

I <b>had jobed</b>	We <b>had jobed</b>
You <b>had jobed</b>	You <b>had jobed</b>
He/She/It <b>had jobed</b>	They <b>had jobed</b>

I <b>had been jobing</b>	We <b>had been jobing</b>
You <b>had been jobing</b>	You <b>had been jobing</b>
He/She/It <b>had been jobing</b>	They <b>had been jobing</b>

I <b>will jobe</b>	We <b>will jobe</b>
You <b>will jobe</b>	You <b>will jobe</b>
He/She/It <b>will jobe</b>	They <b>will jobe</b>

I <b>will be jobing</b>	We <b>will be jobing</b>

**I will have jobed**

**We will have jobed**

**You will have jobed**

**You will have jobed**

**He/She/It will have jobed**

**They will have jobed**

**I will have been jobing**

**We will have been jobing**

**You will have been jobing**

**You will have been jobing**

**He/She/It will have been jobing**

**They will have been jobing**
