I **jump-start** We **jump-start**
You **jump-start** You **jump-start**
He/She/It **jump-starts** They **jump-start**

I **am jump-starting** We **are jump-starting**
You **are jump-starting** You **are jump-starting**
He/She/It **is jump-starting** They **are jump-starting**
