## Associations of "Just as" (30 Words)

<b>applicable</b>	Capable of being applied; having relevance. <i>Gave <b>applicable</b> examples to support her argument.</i>
<a href="#"><b>apposite</b></a>	Apt in the circumstances or in relation to something. <i>The successful copywriter is a master of <b>apposite</b> and evocative verbal images.</i>
<b>appropriate</b>	Take (something) for one’s own use, typically without the owner’s permission. <i>The accused had <b>appropriated</b> the property.</i>
<a href="#"><b>apropos</b></a>	At an opportune time. <i>The composer s reference to child s play is <b>apropos</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><b>barely</b></a>	Openly; explicitly. <i>She <b>barely</b> seemed to notice him.</i>
<b>coincidentally</b>	In a way that results from chance despite being very unlikely. <i>Her dad <b>coincidentally</b> happens to be the accountant at the bank.</i>
<a href="#"><b>commensurate</b></a>	Corresponding in size or degree; in proportion. <i>Pay should be <b>commensurate</b> with the time worked.</i>
<b>congruous</b>	Suitable or appropriate together. <i>This explanation is <b>congruous</b> with earlier observations.</i>
<a href="#"><b>decent</b></a>	Decently clothed. <i>Are you <b>decent</b>.</i>
<b>equal</b>	A person who is of equal standing with another in a group. <i>1 litre is roughly <b>equal</b> to 1 quart.</i>
<a href="#"><b>equally</b></a>	In amounts or parts that are the same in size. <i>They were <b>equally</b> beautiful.</i>
<b>equitable</b>	Fair and impartial. <i>The beneficiaries have an <b>equitable</b> interest in the property.</i>

<b>evenhanded</b>	Without partiality. <i><b>Evenhanded</b> justice.</i>
<b>fair</b>	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. A <i><b>fair</b> fight.</i>
<b>fitting</b>	The action of fitting something. Loose <i><b>fitting</b> trousers.</i>
<b>germane</b>	Relevant to a subject under consideration. <i>That is not <b>germane</b> to our theme.</i>
<b><u>identical</u></b>	(of twins) derived from a single egg or ovum. <i>Four girls in <b>identical</b> green outfits.</i>
<b><u>justice</u></b>	A public official authorized to decide questions brought before a court of justice. <i>A tragic miscarriage of <b>justice</b>.</i>
<b>legitimate</b>	Make an illegitimate child legitimate declare the legitimacy of someone. <i>A <b>legitimate</b> male heir.</i>
<b><u>merely</u></b>	Just; only. <i>Gary a silent boy <b>merely</b> nodded.</i>
<b>pertinent</b>	Relevant or applicable to a particular matter; apposite. <i>Practitioners must consider all factors <b>pertinent</b> to a situation.</i>
<b>proper</b>	Satisfactorily or correctly. <i>We go to the High Mass with plainsong <b>propers</b> sung by the Ritual Choir.</i>
<b><u>relevant</u></b>	Appropriate to the current time, period, or circumstances; of contemporary interest. <i>Her films are <b>relevant</b> for feminists today.</i>
<b>rightness</b>	According with conscience or morality. <i>The <b>rightness</b> of that move for me.</i>
<b>scarcely</b>	Only a very short time before. <i>They <b>scarcely</b> ever used the emergency generator.</i>
<b>seemly</b>	Conforming to accepted notions of propriety or good taste; decorous. <i>I felt it was not <b>seemly</b> to observe too closely.</i>
<b>similar</b>	A person or thing similar to another. <i>A soft cheese <b>similar</b> to Brie.</i>
<b><u>simply</u></b>	Used to introduce a short summary of a situation. <i>They lived very <b>simply</b>.</i>
<b><u>suitable</u></b>	Meant or adapted for an occasion or use. <i>These toys are not <b>suitable</b> for children under five.</i>

Before a time limit expires.

With **timely** treatment the patient has a good chance of recovery.
