Synonyms of "Juxtapose" as a verb (5 Words)

mix	Mix so as to make a random order or arrangement. <i>Up to eight tracks can be mixed simultaneously.</i>
place close to one another	Recognize as being; establish the identity of someone or something.
place side by side	Assign a rank or rating to.
set close to one another	Urge to attack someone.
set side by side	Estimate.

Usage Examples of "Juxtapose" as a verb

- *The fauvists juxtaposed strong colors.*
- *Black-and-white photos of slums were starkly juxtaposed with colour images.*

abut	(of a building or an area of land) be next to or have a common boundary with. <i>Masonry may crumble where a roof abuts it.</i>
adjacent	(of a pair of angles) formed on the same side of a straight line when intersected by another line. <i>New York and adjacent cities.</i>
adjoin	Attach or add. <i>The dining room adjoins a conservatory.</i>
after	At a later or future time afterwards. <i>Duke Frederick died soon after.</i>
at	100 at equal 1 kip in Laos.
distal	Relating to or denoting the outer part of an area affected by geological activity. <i>The distal zone is characterized by pyroclastic flow deposits.</i>
eastern	Of or characteristic of eastern regions of the United States. <i>An eastern wind.</i>
edge	Provide with an edge. <i>The economy was teetering on the edge of recession.</i>
extremity	A condition of extreme adversity. <i>The peninsula s western extremity.</i>
flank	A cut of meat from the flank of an animal. <i>A flanking attack from the north east.</i>
heap	Form a heap. <i>A heap of cardboard boxes.</i>
henceforth	From this time forth; from now on. <i>Henceforth parties which fail to get 5 of the vote will not be represented in parliament.</i>
lateral	A lateral consonant. <i>Lateral sclerosis.</i>

laterally	In a lateral direction or location. <i>Think laterally about new ways of using limited resources.</i>
latticed	Having a pattern of fretwork or latticework. <i>A latticed screen.</i>
medial	(of a vowel) pronounced in the middle of the mouth; central. <i>A medial consonant.</i>
montage	A sequence of film made using the technique of montage. <i>Montage was a useful device for overcoming the drawbacks of silent film.</i>
near	Come near to approach. <i>Near neighbors.</i>
next	The next person or thing. <i>The next item on the list.</i>
ordered	Having a systematic arrangement; especially having elements succeeding in order according to rule. <i>An ordered sequence.</i>
photo	A photo finish. <i>Do we wait till you've had him photoed.</i>
position	An opinion that is held in opposition to another in an argument or dispute. <i>The guns were shelling the German positions.</i>
postmodern	Relating to or characterized by postmodernism especially in being self referential. <i>Postmodernist architecture.</i>
purlieu	The area near or surrounding a place. <i>The photogenic purlieus of Cambridge.</i>
quadrilateral	Having four sides.
side	The amount of writing needed to fill one side of a sheet of paper. <i>The hills that side a long valley.</i>
sometime	Occasional. <i>The Emperor Constantine used this speech sometime unto his bishops.</i>
subsequently	Happening at a time subsequent to a reference time. <i>The officer decided to stop and subsequently made an arrest.</i>
superimpose	Place on top of. <i>The number will appear on the screen superimposed on a flashing button.</i>
then	In that case or as a consequence. <i>We watched the late movie and then went to bed.</i>
