Kayak in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I kayak We kayak
You kayak You kayak
He/She/It kayaks They kayak

Kayak in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am kayaking We are kayaking
You are kayaking You are kayaking
He/She/It is kayaking They are kayaking

Kayak in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I have kayaked We have kayaked
You have kayaked You have kayaked
He/She/It has kayaked They have kayaked

Kayak in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been kayaking We have been kayaking

You have been kayaking You have been kayaking

He/She/It has been kayaking They have been kayaking

Kayak in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I kayaked We kayaked
You kayaked You kayaked
He/She/It kayaked They kayaked

Kayak in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was kayaking We were kayaking
You were kayaking
He/She/It was kayaking They were kayaking

Kayak in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had kayaked
You had kayaked
He/She/It had kayaked
They had kayaked

Kayak in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been kayaking
You had been kayaking
You had been kayaking
He/She/It had been kayaking
They had been kayaking

Kayak in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **will kayak**You **will kayak**He/She/It **will kayak**They **will kayak**

Kayak in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be kayaking
You will be kayaking
He/She/It will be kayaking
They will be kayaking

Kayak in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have kayaked
You will have kayaked
He/She/It will have kayaked
They will have kayaked

Kayak in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been kayaking
You will have been kayaking
He/She/It will have been kayaking
They will have been kayaking
