# **Conjugate Keak**

## Keak in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>keak</b>	We <b>keak</b>
You <b>keak</b>	You <b>keak</b>
He/She/It <b>keaks</b>	They <b>keak</b>

## **Keak in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am keaking</b>	We <b>are keaking</b>
You <b>are keaking</b>	You <b>are keaking</b>
He/She/It is keaking	They <b>are keaking</b>

#### **Keak in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have keaked	We have keaked
You have keaked	You have keaked
He/She/It has keaked	They have keaked

### **Keak in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been keaking	We have been keaking
You <b>have been keaking</b>	You <b>have been keaking</b>
He/She/It has been keaking	They have been keaking

## Keak in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>keaked</b>	We <b>keaked</b>
You <b>keaked</b>	You <b>keaked</b>
He/She/It <b>keaked</b>	They $\boldsymbol{keaked}$

#### Keak in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was keaking	We <b>were keaking</b>
You <b>were keaking</b>	You <b>were keaking</b>
He/She/It was keaking	They were keaking

#### **Keak in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had keaked	We had keaked
You <b>had keaked</b>	You <b>had keaked</b>
He/She/It had keaked	They had keaked

## **Keak in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been keaking	We had been keaking
You <b>had been keaking</b>	You <b>had been keaking</b>
He/She/It had been keaking	They had been keaking

## Keak in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will keak</b>	We <b>will keak</b>
You <b>will keak</b>	You <b>will keak</b>
He/She/It will keak	They <b>will keak</b>

## **Keak in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be keaking	We <b>will be keaking</b>
You <b>will be keaking</b>	You <b>will be keaking</b>
He/She/It will be keaking	They will be keaking

### **Keak in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have keakedWe will have keakedYou will have keakedYou will have keakedHe/She/It will have keakedThey will have keaked

#### **Keak in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been keaking	We <b>will have been keaking</b>
You <b>will have been keaking</b>	You <b>will have been keaking</b>
He/She/It will have been keaking	They will have been keaking
